

The Eucharistic Revival- The Eucharist, did you know?

How is God present to us? God is present to us through both general and particular forms of revelation. We believe that God is present "everywhere" and "always" as the creator and sustainer of our existence. As St. Elizabeth Seton said, "God is everywhere, in the very air I breathe, yes everywhere, but in this sacrament of the altar, God is as present actually and really as my soul within my body; in this sacrifice daily offered, {God is present} as really as {when} once offered on the Cross."

We also believe that God chooses to reveal God's own reality to us through particular created realities, most importantly, through the person of Jesus of Nazareth. Theologian Richard McBrien in his book Catholicism (p.262) explains that "Because God is totally other than we are, because God is totally of the spiritual order, because God, therefore, is not visible to our bodily senses, our experience of God is always mediated. We experience the reality of God through our experience of created things, or particular persons, or particular events, or through a psychic sense of divine presence (mysticism). Consequently, every contact with God is mysterious, or sacramental. The hidden God completely permeates a visible reality. In grasping that visible reality we grasp the hidden God." 
