## Summary of Updates to COVID-19 Protocols at St. Rita Church

### For the 5:00 PM Saturday Mass and the 10:30 AM Sunday Mass and Daily Mass:

- ◆ There will be expanded seating areas where physical distancing is NOT required. In these areas, masks will be optional.
- ◆ There will be seating areas where physical distancing IS required. In these areas, masks will be required.

### For the 8:00 AM Mass:

- ◆ Masks will be required in all areas.
- ◆ There will be seating areas where physical distancing is NOT required.

This Mass option is intended to provide a safe space for the most vulnerable to attend Mass. This may be a good option for families with children who are too young for vaccines.

Please follow the directions of the Hospitality Ministers as they direct you to the appropriate areas or specific seats.

**For the safety of everyone, we kindly ask that you continue to wear your mask as you enter and exit the church as you may cross paths closely with someone who may be vulnerable.**

**Gospel Reading****Mk 4:26-34**

A Reading from the holy Gospel according to Mark

Jesus said to the crowds: "This is how it is with the kingdom of God; it is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how. Of its own accord the land yields fruit, first the blade, then the ear, then the full grain in the ear. And when the grain is ripe, he wields the sickle at once, for the harvest has come."

He said, "To what shall we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable can we use for it? It is like a mustard seed that, when it is sown in the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on the earth. But once it is sown, it springs up and becomes the largest of plants and puts forth large branches, so that the birds of the sky can dwell in its shade." With many such parables he spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it. Without parables he did not speak to them, but to his own disciples he explained everything in private.

## Reflections on our Readings for The 11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

### “The Seed Would Sprout And Grow, He Knows Not How”

Our Scripture readings this Sunday focus our attention on the small seed (or small shoot) that, with the grace of God, will grow into a mighty tree with room for all the birds of the sky (people of all nations). It can be a comparison with the growth of our Church which started with the seed planted by Jesus and with just twelve apostles, grew so large that all peoples and all nations can live within it.

In our first reading ([Ezekiel 17:22-24](#)), we hear the beautiful allegory representing God's restoration of Israel, the Messianic Kingdom. So great will this majestic cedar be that *"birds of every kind shall dwell beneath it."* In the Christological sense, the *"tender shoot"* can be seen to represent the Messiah, the Christ, plucked from the majestic tree of David.

In our Epistle reading ([2 Corinthians 5:6-10](#)), St. Paul teaches us that our life here on earth is temporary. Our bodies are but a home away from home; we are restless until we rest in the Lord. At death, we will "receive recompense" for the merits of our life here on earth.

In our Gospel reading ([Mark 4:26-34](#)), Jesus relates two parables about seeds that teach us that God is the source of all growth and that even the smallest of beginnings, nourished by God, can change the world for good.

We sometimes have two roles. At times, we are the fertile ground in which God plants his seed and with God's grace, produces much fruit. At other times, we are the sowers of the seeds God gives us to plant. We, in our aspirations of grandeur, sometimes look for the largest of seeds to plant, when in reality, it is often the smallest of seeds, the smallest of deeds, that bear the most fruit. It is not for us to know what becomes of the seed. *"Of its own accord, the land yields fruit"*. We, grateful for the opportunity to sow the seeds, must trust in God's wisdom.

Here is a small prayer taken from the evening liturgy of the hours that may add perspective to today's readings: *"You command the seed to rise, Lord God, though the farmer is unaware. Grant that those who labor for you may trust not in their own work but in your help. Remembering that the land is brought to flower not with human tears but with those of your Son, may the Church rely only upon your gifts."*




