## CHURCH LIBRARY

"Love the Lord your God with all your mind."



**St. Rita Parish Library** is located just inside the main church entrance. In the past, John Facci and Darlene Piersall spent many years organizing and caring for the library collection and making sure that the space was attractive and welcoming. Unfortunately, the COVID pandemic led to a significant backlog of donations that were unprocessed. Three parishioners recently reviewed those donations.

We now have an opportunity to rethink our library as a disciple-making center. We are proposing that in addition to finding and checking out books or media, a Parish Library can be a place to find information about missions and service opportunities, pick up prayer and discipleship resources, or as a meeting point for conversation.

To do so requires an understanding of the current collection by examining its strengths and weaknesses; working with leaders, ministries, and parishioners to identify collection opportunities, and systematically reviewing for threats that lead to the collection's disuse.

**Mission Statement:** St. Rita's Parish Library's mission is to encourage, support, and enrich the spiritual and intellectual growth of our parishioners by providing educational and inspirational books, DVDs, and CDs that are consistent with the teachings of the Catholic Church.

### Goals:

- ◆ To be an instrument of God's love by fostering spiritual growth
- ◆ To provide materials that follow the Magisterium of the Church
- ◆ To present materials in an organized manner

## Reflections on our Readings for The 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus Sends The Twelve Apostles

### “In Him We Were Also Chosen”

This Sunday's readings highlight the calling by God of ordinary people (regular Joe's and Jill's) to preach the Gospel. In last Sunday's readings, we learned about our calling as prophets, to speak God's truth to those around us. This Sunday's readings continue that theme as Jesus sends his twelve apostles on a mission to preach repentance and to cast out demons and cure the sick.

In our first reading (Amos 7:12-15), we hear the prophet Amos being rejected by the priest Amaziah. Amos responded that he was not a professional prophet but an ordinary shepherd called by God from his life as a shepherd. In short, his call by God was much greater than anything Amaziah could say to him.

In our Epistle reading (Ephesians 1:3-14), we hear from the opening of Paul's letter to the Ephesian community. It is both a blessing and a teaching. In this passage, Paul teaches us that we are chosen by God and redeemed by the blood of Christ. In Christ, we are destined with the purpose of the will of God. We are called to glorify God with our lives.

In our Gospel reading (Mark 6:7-13), Jesus sent his twelve apostles on a mission of preaching and healing. (The word “apostle” means “one who is sent”). They were to take nothing with them, relying totally on God and the community for their sustenance. And while not everyone would accept their message, they were not to dwell but to move on to other areas and people to continue their preaching and healing.

Like Amos the Prophet and the twelve Apostles, St. Paul tells us, we also have been chosen by God “before the foundation of the world”. Chosen for what? To praise and glorify God with our lives, to preach God's truth by living and loving as God would have us do. It was not we who chose God but God who chose us.




