





Preparation Process for Adult Confirmation

The diocesan preparation program for those adults (18+) seeking to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation is intended to provide catechetical instruction in the faith, as well as spiritual support to compliment the parish in the formation of candidates, who are completing their initiation in the Catholic Church.

Prior to registration, candidates must begin this process by meeting with the pastor to:

- * Gather canonical documents,
- * Determine if there are any impediments to the reception of the Sac rament.
- *Ascertain desire and disposition of the inquirer requesting the Sacrament.

At the conclusion of the preparation program, pastors should meet with the candidate to reflect on their experience and to verify the suitability of the sponsor before submitting the conferral form for the actual reception of the Sacrament.

The preparation is a hybrid program, with <u>both</u> virtual and in-person sessions for candidates to attend during the Fall.

Participants who miss two or more sessions may be asked to postpone the reception of the Sacrament to the following semester, if the content which has been missed cannot be made up in some way.

Participants are asked to share their screens during virtual sessions.

From Fr. Mike,

Again, Happy New Year! As mentioned in my column last week, I shared the Diocese requires all parishes to have Parish Councils and



Finance Councils. Yes, we are in compliance but the Pandemic has really been the central theme of all. It has forced us not to meet as a group and we also have to keep in mind we are a collaborative of parishes which we enter into year 3 as of June. A few weeks ago, I sat down with the members of the pastoral planning team from the diocese just to give an overview of how things were going. It was a very cordial meeting. In our discussion, I brought up the issue of parish councils and finance councils and how we can better work together as a collaborative. I was asked to wait until after Christmas to discuss our thoughts and was given the go ahead to form a collaborative parish council and a collaborative finance council. The one thing I want to make clear is that even though we will become a collaborative council, the finances of each parish will stay separate. My goal is to have our new collaborative councils in place by the 31st of March. Until then, all current members will remain. So how do we form this council?

I am looking for 4 members from each parish to establish the new parish collaborative council and four members of each parish to establish the new collaborative finance council. Those with a financial background are strongly encouraged to come forward. Current members of the present councils are also invited to come forward and be members. However, once the new councils are formed, new chairs of the council will be chosen at the first meeting. Honorary members of the councils are Pastors, Deacons, Religious Ed Coordinators and our parish bookkeeper, Leslie Moujabber is automatically a member of the Finance Council as she will be able to help us in discussions of our finances.

How do I become a member? Below is a form to fill out expressing your interest of becoming a member of either the Parish Council or Finance Council. Once the form is received and reviewed, you will receive a call from Fr. Mike with further details of your becoming a member.

Can I be part of both councils? The answer is yes with approval of the Pastor particularly if one has financial background and would like to be part of the finance Council.

I look forward to working and starting new as a collaborative in this new year. Have a good week! Fr. Mike
