

Unfortunately, the Food Pantry has had a few setbacks in the last couple of weeks.

of weeks. One of our large freezers broke down and we did lose some meats. We had to purchase another freezer. We are having trouble getting some of the items from the Boston Food Bank that we usually get for free, starting with meat so we have had to pay for meat items to pass out. Also, our delivery site where we pick up food from the Boston Food Bank has been moved from New Bedford to Fall River. We now have to pay approximately \$50 more for our box truck rental two times a month. Each week we have between 12 to 20 new families arriving at our door, so our food budget is definitely getting stretched. If there is anything you can do to help our situation, it would be greatly appreciated. The Food Pantry will be open Friday, July 15th from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. If you know of anyone in need, PLEASE tell them about your Food Pantry. We still need help carrying grocery bags out to the parking lot for our clients in need. Stop by and meet our group of volunteers. We're a very friendly bunch!!! We are located in the basement of St. Lawrence Rectory at 110


