

Preparation for Adult Confirmation

The diocesan preparation program for adults (18+) seeking to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation is intended to provide instruction in the faith, as well as spiritual support to compliment the parish in the formation of candidates who are completing their initiation in the Catholic Church. Prior to registration, candidates must begin this process by meeting with the pastor to gather documents.

This program consists of seven sessions total, with both virtual and in-person sessions.

Attendance at all sessions is mandatory. Participants are asked to share their screens during virtual sessions.

Mass on the 26th Anniversary of the passing of St. Teresa of Calcutta

Members of the Missionaries of Charity of New Bedford, the religious order founded by Mother Teresa who minister in our city, extend an invitation to all to attend a special Mass to be offered for her on the anniversary of her death. Mass will be celebrated at St. Lawrence Martyr on <u>September 5th at 11AM</u>.

The church was the site of the Mass celebrated by then Fall River Bishop Sean O'Malley, OFM Cap., in honor of Mother Teresa's visit to the Diocese of Fall River in June of 1995. St. Lawrence Martyr is the parish of the Missionaries of Charity whose convent is located across the street.

Did you know...

Pope Francis recently updated and made permanent his motu proprio *Vos estis lux mundi* (You are the light of the world). In May 2019, Pope Francis established new norms regarding the requirement to ensure adequate processing of reports of sexual abuse by priests or members of religious life. The new document makes permanent these important protections for those reporting abuse and holds Church leaders accountable for any failures to carry out their responsibilities in this regard.

Much of what is outlined in *Vos estis lux mundi*, has been in place in the United States since 2002 with the establishment of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* (Dallas Charter) The Charter created a set of procedures for handling allegations of sexual abuse of a minor, whether historical or current. It calls for all allegations to be reported to local law enforcement, zero tolerance for clergy with credible allegations returning to ministry, and establishment of outreach and healing services for survivors.
