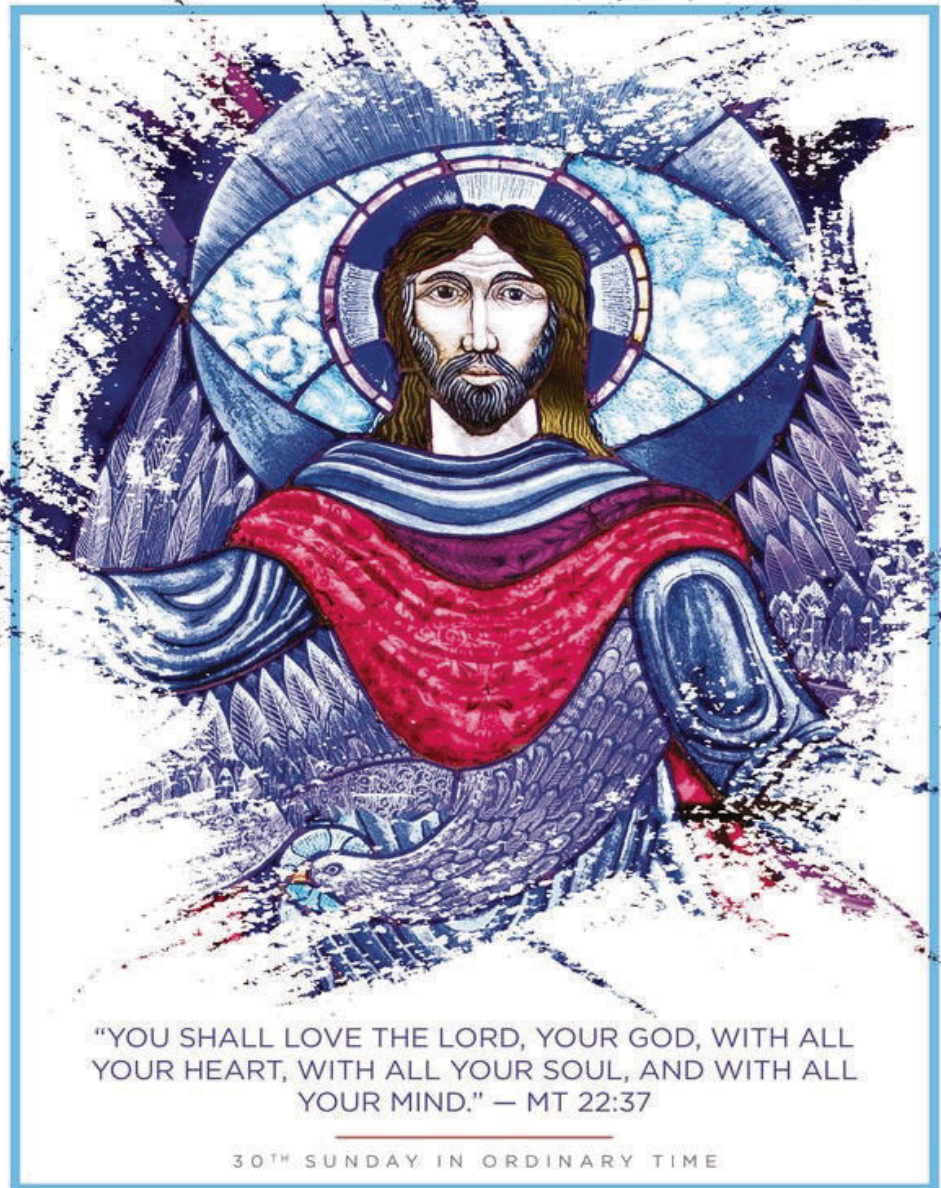

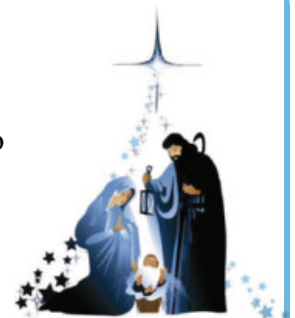


### Annual Memorial Mass

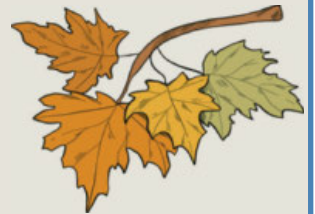

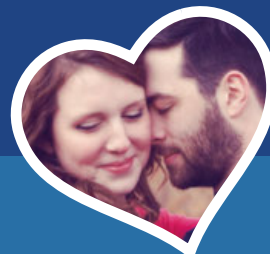
