#### Embracing Change in Christ

It's officially one month since we popped the champagne, toasted 2021 and wrote down a list of resolutions. This is usually the time when we start to take a good, hard look in the mirror to assess what we have done — or have not done — with the first month of this brand-new year.

New years can be scary, can't they? Full of promise, sure, but also full of room for failure. Full of space for our old baggage, old fears and the continuation of old mistakes.

The same can be said of Christ, and the new life he offers us, if we are brave enough to accept it. Opportunities like that can be intimidating. In that moment, we might find ourselves like the man with the unclean spirit crying out: "What have you to do with me, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us?"

## Parking at St. Lawrence

With the recent opening of the Apartment Building 121 North in the former Holy Family High School it is imperative to know that the property is no longer part of St. Lawrence Church and that we are now neighbors. This means that parking in the additional spaces near the rectory is for the residents only on 121 and that no other cars are allowed to use those spaces particularly on Sunday Mornings or any Church functions. This is Private Property and cars not belonging to the apartment building owners are subject to being towed and cameras are recording vehicles parked in the lot. Please be courteous and good neighbors.

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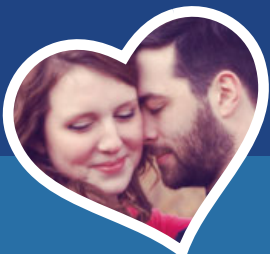
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
