

Food Pantry News

Thank you so much for all the cans of soup you donated to our SOUP-A-BOWL!! You are so generous. We can always count on you! Also, thank you for all the other donations including children's cereals, which are always needed. I will let you know the final count of how many cans of soup we received as soon as they are all counted.

Unfortunately, we received troubling news recently. For the past 20 years the inmates from the Dartmouth House of Corrections have loaded and unloaded our deliveries from the Boston Food Bank. Presently we pick up our food in Fall River and the inmates load our U-Haul. Now, Boston is changing our pick-up site to Wareham and the inmates can no longer help because Wareham is in a different county. They have worked very hard for us over the years and we really appreciate them and the program.

We are now looking for 4 to 6 dependable men to load our truck in Wareham.

Our deliveries are on the second and fourth Tuesdays of the month at 9 a.m. We pick up 6,000 pounds of food and it takes less than an hour to load the truck. If you can help in this great need, please call Kathy Boucher at 508 991-1042.

If you can't help, please **pray** that we find the help we need. Thank you!

The Food Pantry will be open on March 1st from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. and is located in the basement of St. Lawrence Rectory, 110 Summer St.

If you can't feed a hundred people, then just feed one. St. Teresa of Calcutta Throughout the day on Ash Wednesday, approximately 350 people from our faith community attended Mass. I am very pleased to say thank you for your wonderful participation as we enter the Lenten season. Mass with distribution of ashes was celebrated at all three churches, we are indeed blessed by your devotion.

Preparation for Adult Confirmation

The diocesan preparation program for adults (18+) seeking to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation is intended to provide instruction in the faith, as well as spiritual support to compliment the parish in the formation of candidates who are completing their initiation in the Catholic Church.

Prior to registration, candidates must begin this process by meeting with the pastor to gather documents.

This program consists of seven sessions total, with both virtual and in-person sessions.

Attendance at all sessions is mandatory. Participants are asked to share their screens during virtual sessions.
