



CHORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

The Corpus Christi procession, is a public witness of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament. A Catholic tradition that takes place on the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, or Corpus Christi where we express our devotion to Christ to honor the Blessed Sacrament and demonstrate our faith in the Real Presence of Christ.

During the procession the Blessed Sacrament, placed in a monstrance, carried out of the church and through the streets accompanied by the songs and prayers of the people. It is an outward demonstration of Catholic faith, and a physical enactment of going with God, of Catholics symbolically bringing God and their faith into the world.

Often there are altars decorated along the route where the monstrance is placed and the people are blessed. In this way the Church shows that Christ, here among us, walks with us on our pilgrimage to heaven.
