Faith Formation Corner

Now that Faith Formation is under way I can write about something other than registration! In a recent homily, Deacon Maurice spoke about the importance of living our faith through, not just words, but by example. I cannot tell you how much this sentiment resonates with me. Words not backed by actions can be seen as empty, hollow. Actions truly do speak louder than words. I don't necessarily talk about my faith a whole lot outside of the bulletin, but I always try to live my faith. Here's one recent example. My son plays hockey and I tend to cheer for the team...very loudly. As you know, names are very important to me, so, I also cheer for each individual child on his team. I **always** keep my words positive and encouraging. One mom of a new player commented to my husband how much she loves my positive energy! (This was funny because he had said I was insane at this exact same game, I was cheering so much.) I am screaming and yelling but I am never being rude, disrespectful or hurtful. People notice; people also notice if you say you are a Christian but then are swearing, insulting, intolerant, etc. We can show our faith and God's love for each other in any situation we're in, even hockey games. So, see, Deacon Maurice, I was listening and I agree with you :)
