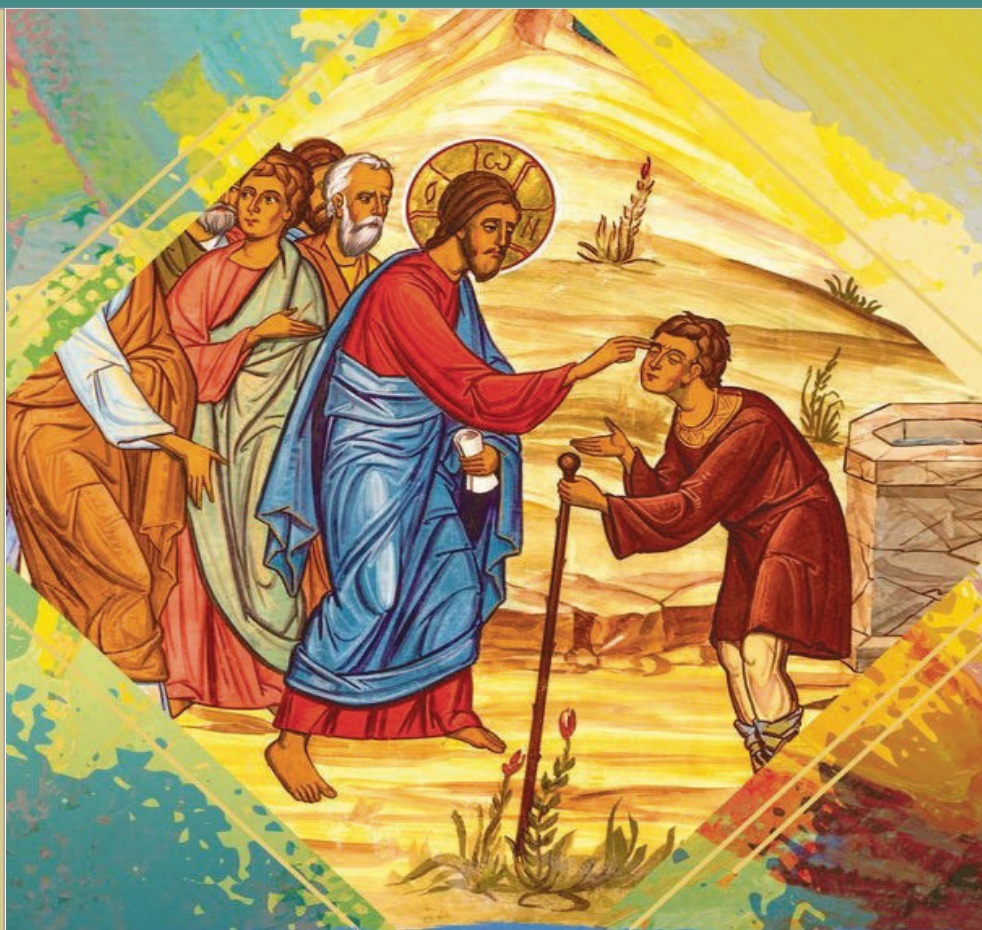

### ***Faith Formation Corner***

Did you get a chance to see the comet that has been visible the last week or so? It's name is Comet Tsuchinshan-ATLAS (C/2023) and since mid October it has been visible to the naked eye in the western sky just after sunset. I am a huge fan of astronomy! I'm by no means an expert, I, honestly, am confused by most of it but still love it! I have this app on my phone called "Night Sky" that will tell me what I am looking at when I point the phone at an area of sky. The last time this comet was visible to Earth was 80,000 years ago and the next time it's visible won't be for another 80,000 years so I made sure to take advantage of my chance!

For me, looking at the night sky always makes me feel closer to God. Gazing into the heavens, seeing stars that are so far away and have been there for longer than I can even begin to comprehend, just gives this sense of awe. God created that! And He created us! As hectic and messy day to day life can be, just a few seconds looking up at night can bring a sense of calm to me. God is there. He's always there and is so much bigger than any problems in my life.
