



FAMILY PREP NEEDS YOU! Do you have a passion for sharing the love of Jesus? Consider serving as a program facilitator, tech coordinator or class mentor for grades 1,2,4,5 or 6 during the 2022-2023 Parish Religious Education Program. The Family program meets the first Sunday of the month (Oct, Nov, Jan, Feb, Apr) from 9:40-11:00 am. Program facilitators open each session with prayer and a large group discussion/activity. Mentors then accompany children to the classrooms for a youth-friendly activity while the adults remain in the parish center to watch a video or to enjoy a quest speaker. We also need tech coordinators of all ages to assist in Level 3, which meets twice a month on Sunday evening from 6-7:15 pm. What is a Living Rosary? Beginning in France in the 1800's and practiced by St. John Paul II, the Living Rosary bears in common the practice of a group of people representing the prayers of the Rosary, and sharing in praying the Rosary together. Each person is responsible for one decade a day, so that a full Rosary is prayed by the group each day - Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful, and Glorious Mysteries. You pray the same decade for one year - meditating intimately on that one mystery. You may include the Opening and Closing Prayers of the Rosary. Living Rosary is a way to make you feel like a part of a close prayer community, even though you don't meet in person.
