CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

RETURNS - Children in pre-school through 3rd grade are encouraged to participate on the 3rd Sunday of the month at the 10:30 am Mass. beginning September 18th. Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLW) extends the church's hospitality to children who are called, like everyone else, to grow in their faith through liturgical celebrations. During CLW, young children leave the sanctuary after the Opening Prayer and move to the chapel where they hear the Gospel proclaimed and discussed at an ageappropriate level. The children return to the Mass during the offertory procession. Parents/Guardians, if your child isn't comfortable coming forward for the children's dismissal, you can accompany your child to the chapel.
