

PARISH UPDATES

- <u>Kitchen Renovation</u> The Property Management Committee has made significant progress upgrading the kitchen. To date, all of the kitchen cabinets have been removed and replaced with new. Granite counter tops with undermount sink are scheduled for installation. A new floor has been installed, the old cast iron radiator has been removed and replaced with an electric toe kick heater, a new stove has been installed including a microwave with an outside vent. There are numerous electrical and plumbing improvements being implemented along with painting and installation of new hardware. Donations are being received to help defray the costs.
- Carillon System The weekend pre- Mass songs that you have been enjoying do not originate from a cloud. They are due to the dedicated efforts of Ellen O'Shaughnessy, who researches the appropriate songs for the specific weekend Mass liturgy. The songs are sent to Nancy DiGiacomo, who diligently and patiently programs the songs onto the Sonata Carillon. Per the carillon vendor, we are the only parish who implements this effort. Enjoy!
- <u>Church Heating/Cooling System -</u> A new upgraded control system has been mostly installed with remote control. There are ongoing adjustments that need to be programmed to meet specific needs; however, the system reliability has been improved. It allows the priests to easily schedule heating & cooling events based on the needs of various functions
