

LENTEN RECIPE SPINACH LASAGNA ROLL-UPS

INGREDIENTS

2 large eggs, lightly beaten 1 package (10 oz.) frozen chopped spinach, thawed and squeezed dry

12 Uncooked lasagna noodles

2 1/2 cups whole milk ricotta cheese

2 1/2 cups shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese

1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese

1/4 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon pepper

1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1 jar (24 oz.) meatless pasta sauce

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 375°. Cook noodles according to package directions; drain. Meanwhile, mix eggs, spinach, cheeses and seasonings.

Pour 1 cup pasta sauce into an ungreased 13x9 in. baking dish Spread1/3 cup cheese mixture over each noodle; roll up and place over sauce, seam side down. Top with remaining sauce. Bake, covered, 20 minutes

Uncover; bake until heated through, 5 to 10 minutes longer.

Living through grief is not easy but it does not have to be done alone. Blessed Sacrament Parish will offer a 9 week support program called, "New Day", for those who have suffered the loss of a loved one. The goal of this program is to provide a sense of community where support is given and received.

The program is led by trained facilitators and includes prayer, discussion, and journaling. Although New Day is a faith-based program, it is not restricted to Catholics and all are welcome.
