### LENTEN RECIPE

### Creamy Irish Potato Soup

### Ingredients

2 tablespoons butter or margarine
4 medium green onions, sliced
1 stalk celery, sliced
3 medium potatoes, peeled and sliced 1/4 inch thick
1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cups Swanson® Chicken Broth or Swanson®
