





## From the desk of Fr. Sullivan

Dear Friends,

All of us are sinners. We know that. As weak, fallen human beings we have a tendency towards sin and all of us if we look honestly towards ourselves have to humbly admit this weakness. Big or little, mortal or venial, our sins keep us from fully experiencing the depth of love we are called to. Saints in many ways, and with God's grace, have conquered many of their faults. This requires great effort as the spiritual battle is very real. We are all called to be saints, yet the attractions and distractions of the world often keep us from what we are meant to be.


What are some of the means to help a human person increase spiritually? How do we achieve, receive or merit this help, this grace, this divine help? The answer may appear simple. Grace, first of all, is a gift, yet it can be received by all those who seek it. God's generosity knows no limits. The Mass, reception of the Eucharist, the Sacrament of Confession and the other sacraments are divine aids on the journey of life.

God gives to his people another gift, a gift through His Church, the body of Christ. This gift is a word we have all heard perhaps many times but few understand its meaning. That word is "indulgence". What is an indulgence and how does it apply to our spiritual lives? An indulgence is the extra-sacramental remission of the temporal punishment due in God's justice, to sins already forgiven. This remission is granted by the Church, either partial (partial indulgence) or total (plenary indulgence). It is the super abundant merits of Christ and the saints applied to us. Just like a kidney can be transplanted, so too in a spiritual sense, the merits of Christ and the saint are applied. As sinners, there is a penalty due to sin. In short, an indulgence takes away the penalty and we are free of it. What an incredible gift this is!

During this Year of St. Joseph, every Wednesday and the 19th day of the month are opportunities to gain plenary indulgences. There is more information provided on a separate page or visit this website: [yearofstjoseph.org/indulgences](http://yearofstjoseph.org/indulgences)

Since we are a Basilica (only one of 69 in the United States) and as a Basilica, we are part of the Papal household, a plenary indulgence is granted on several special days in the course of the year. Please read the bulletin page explaining in more detail what an indulgence is and other conditions that must be met to obtain a plenary indulgence. There are also feast days we are to celebrate in a special way, one of which is this Monday, February 22, the feast of the Chair of St. Peter, when we celebrate the authority of the universal bishop. It is the authority given by Jesus to Peter to lead and guide the Church in Jesus' place. For Jesus told Peter that "you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church . . ." (Mt 16:18).



## Plenary Indulgence during the Year of St. Joseph and Four Prayers to St. Joseph

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions (Sacramental confession, Reception of Holy Communion, and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father) to the faithful who, with a spirit detached from any sin, participate in the Year of Saint Joseph on the occasions and in the manner indicated by this Apostolic Penitentiary:

- \* Meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Our Father
- \* Participate in a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on Saint Joseph
  - \* Perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy
  - \* Recite the Holy Rosary in families and between the husband and wife
- \* Entrust their work daily to the protection of Saint Joseph and to all believers who invoke with their prayers the intercession of the worker of Nazareth
- \* Pray the litany of Saint Joseph for the persecuted Church and for the relief of all persecuted Christians
  - \* Pray any lawfully approved prayer or act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph, especially on:  
**March 19** (Solemnity of St. Joseph), **May 1** (Feast of St. Joseph the Worker), **December 26** (Feast of the Holy Family),  
the **19th day of every month**, and **every Wednesday** (a day dedicated to the memory of the Saint).

The gift of plenary indulgence extends particularly to: the elderly, the sick, the dying and all those who for legitimate reasons cannot leave their home - who, with the spirit detached from any sin and with the intention of fulfilling, as soon as possible, the three usual conditions, in your own home or wherever the impediment holds you, pray an act of piety in honor of Saint Joseph, consolation of the sick and patron of good death, confidently offering God the pains and difficulties of his life.

### The Year of St. Joseph Prayer

*To you, O blessed Joseph, do we come in our afflictions, and having implored the help of your most holy Spouse, we confidently invoke your patronage also.*

*Through that charity which bound you to the Immaculate Virgin Mother of God and through the paternal love with which you embraced the Child Jesus, we humbly beg you graciously to regard the inheritance which Jesus Christ has purchased by his Blood, and with your power and strength to aid us in our necessities.*

*O most watchful guardian of the Holy Family, defend the chosen children of Jesus Christ;  
O most loving father, ward off from us every contagion of error and corrupting influence;  
O our most mighty protector, be kind to us and from heaven assist us in our struggle with the power of darkness.*

*As once you rescued the Child Jesus from deadly peril, so now protect God's Holy Church from the snares of the enemy and from all adversity; shield, too, each one of us by your constant protection, so that, supported by your example and your aid, we may be able to live piously, to die in holiness, and to obtain eternal happiness in heaven. Amen.*

### Memorare to St. Joseph

*Remember, O most pure spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary, my great protector, Saint Joseph, that no one ever had recourse to your protection, or implored your aid without obtaining relief. Confiding therefore in your goodness, I come before you. Do not turn down my petitions, foster father of the Redeemer, but graciously receive them. Amen.*

### Prayer Before Work to St. Joseph the Worker

*O Glorious Saint Joseph,  
model of all those who are devoted to labor,  
obtain for me the grace to work in a spirit of penance for the expiation of my many sins;  
to work conscientiously, putting the call of duty above my natural inclinations; to work with thankfulness and joy, considering it an honor to employ and develop by means of labor the gifts received from God;  
to work with order, peace, moderation, and patience, never shrinking from weariness and trials;  
to work above all with purity of intention and detachment from self,  
keeping unceasingly before my eyes death and the account that I must give of time lost, talents unused, good omitted, and vain complacency in success, so fatal to the work of God.*

*All for Jesus, all through Mary,  
all after thy example, O Patriarch, Saint Joseph.  
Such shall be my watch-word in life and in death. Amen.*

### Act of Consecration to St. Joseph

*O dearest St. Joseph, I consecrate myself to your honor and give myself to you, that you may always be my father, my protector and my guide in the way of salvation. Obtain for me a greater purity of heart and fervent love of the interior life. After your example may I do all my actions for the greater glory of God, in union with the Divine Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. O Blessed St. Joseph, pray for me, that I may share in the peace and joy of your holy death. Amen.*

## Plenary Indulgence

### Spiritual Privileges for Visitors

The bestowal of the title of minor basilica initiated a very particular bond between the church and the Holy Father and set the church apart in rank from other churches. While the principal church of the Archdiocese of Hartford is the Cathedral of Saint Joseph, where the cathedra is found, the chair of the Archbishop and sign of his teaching office, the Basilica ranks after the Cathedral as a church of great distinction.

Spiritual benefits are attached to the designation of a church as a minor basilica. All Catholics who are properly disposed may seek a plenary indulgence by visiting the Basilica on specified days and by fulfilling the conditions that are required.

### What is an indulgence?

An indulgence is a favor granted to an individual by the Church through the merits of Christ that removes, either partially or completely (plenary), the temporal punishment that remains for sins that have been forgiven. Indulgences do not remove sin, that is, the guilt of sin. Serious sin that has been confessed to a priest with sincere contrition and a resolve to sin no more, is forgiven in the Sacrament of Penance. This sacrament also removes the eternal punishment that such a grave offense against God would merit. But, once forgiven, the wounds and effects of our sins remain and block the full action of the Holy Spirit within us. The Church teaches that we must undergo temporal punishment in this life or after death, in Purgatory, to remove the effects of sin and prepare us for eternal happiness with God in heaven. Temporal punishment may be removed now by voluntarily uniting our sufferings in this life with those of Christ and by our prayer and acts of charity. Temporal punishment also may be diminished or removed by a partial or plenary indulgence.

### Who can gain an indulgence?

Catholics in full communion with the Church, may obtain a plenary indulgence once a day for themselves or for a soul in purgatory by carrying out a specified act of devotion with sincerity and in accord with the conditions set by the Church. Those who seek an indulgence must be earnestly striving to eliminate all attachment to sin, whether mortal or venial.

The act of devotion required to obtain the plenary indulgence attached to the Basilica on the days specified may be a devout visit to the Basilica with recitation of the Lord's Prayer and the Creed. In addition, the visit may include: Mass, Benediction, Liturgy of the Hours, Stations of the Cross, the Rosary or another devotion the Blessed Virgin Mary, a period of adoration and meditation before the Blessed Sacrament exposed or reposed in the tabernacle of another pious action.

### The three conditions to be fulfilled:

- 1) Sacramental Confession within 20 days prior to or following the day the indulgence is sought
- 2) Reception of Holy Communion, preferably on the day the indulgence is sought.
- 3) Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father on the day the indulgence is sought.  
(*This might be an Our Father and Hail Mary or other preferred prayers.*)

A plenary indulgence may be gained on the following days by visiting the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception:

- ♦ **February 9** *Date of concession of the title Minor Basilica in 2008*
- ♦ **May 20** *Date of the dedication of the Church of the Immaculate Conception, in 1928*
- ♦ **June 29** *The Solemnity of the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul*
- ♦ **August 14** *Death of Blessed Michael McGivney, founder of the Knights of Columbus, in 1890*
- ♦ **December 8** *Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary*
- ♦ Visitors may select **one day each year** to seek a plenary indulgence
