





### From the desk of Fr. Sullivan

Dear Friends,

Our parish advent mission this past week was truly inspiring. Normally, Advent and Lenten missions are conducted by one person over the course of several days with a focus on a particular theme. A mission is in a sense a miniature parish retreat with the goal of deepening our relationship with Christ and expanding our knowledge of our faith.


The theme of our Advent mission was forgiveness. Once, I heard a priest say in a homily, "God has a name, and that name is Mercy." What we celebrate on Christmas Day is the birth of mercy itself, in the Christ child. God became man to save us. To save us from what? To save us from sin, and all its ugly consequences, and thus out of love for us to bring us to eternal life in heaven.

There are, it seems to me, three forms of forgiveness. One, forgiveness of others. Two, forgiveness of self. And three, forgiveness of God. On the first and second day of our mission, we heard amazing stories of forgiveness and how that forgiveness brought freedom. Forgiveness does not erase what happened, nor does it take away the pain that was inflicted. But it does free us from the hatred that binds us. There is an ancient Chinese expression, "He who seeks revenge must dig two graves, one for the person who is not forgiven, and one for himself."

Our speakers talked about forgiveness of others who had inflicted great pain and hardship upon them. They began to realize that their hardness of heart bound and shackled them. Their pain and hatred was turning on them, and one speaker (Charlie Williams) even said he was becoming like the person he hated.

As I write this letter, it is Thursday morning, and the third night of the mission has not yet occurred. As part of the Mass that will be celebrated tonight (a Mass of Forgiveness and Reconciliation) I will be preaching on perhaps that most difficult aspect of forgiveness: that of forgiving oneself. Very often when we recognize our sin, and hatred of others, when we stand naked before God, we also beg to realize the pain we have inflicted on others through our own pride, greed, and selfishness. As our relationship to Christ deepens, our relationship with love itself, we begin to see that "the person in the mirror" is flawed and in need of God's mercy. With the light of Christ shining on us the disfigured person in the mirror begins to look beautiful, and love of self grows again. We become free of self-loathing, and the darkness that was once there is replaced by an interior life of love in Christ. We then become whole again, and free. And we are able to sing like Mary, "My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior!"
