





From the desk of Fr. Sallivan

My friends,

This week's bulletin letter will be a report/update on a number of plans and initiatives happening at the Basilica in terms of the physical plant.

This past week, I wrote a letter to Archbishop Blair seeking permission to convert the existing three-car garage into a handicap-accessible meeting room. As the parish grows, we will need additional meeting space. The garage is perfect because there is easy access to water (for bathroom and kitchenette) and it is a perfect size for most meetings of 40 people and less. The plans for a new garage will be proposed next year.

A new boiler is needed in the rectory. It was actually needed two years ago, but we have been able to nurse it along for two winters. We are in the process of getting quotes. The heating system in the entire Basilica was completed three years ago. The asbestos in the rectory basement has been properly abated.

The largest project is the Blessed Michael McGivney Parish Center. Things are moving along but not nearly at the pace I had hoped. Part of this is my own fault. Having been in the contracting profession for 25 years, I wanted to act as general contractor for the project. This will result in very substantial savings, but my schedule is filled each and every day, so I am lagging in respect to the hall. I may have to seek help in this regard. Progress is happening, however. In the past few months, artist Paul Armesto has continued painting. The reception area and closets are 95% complete and painted. The statue of Blessed Michael McGivney along with the widow and orphan is done and being shipped from the Philippines in the next few weeks. After countless phone calls by a very helpful parishioner as well as a staff person, we believe we have found a contractor to melt our Waterbury brass and make the dedication plates for the pews. We delivered the brass last week.

The stage area is completely sanded and painted. The kitchen appliances are about to be ordered along with the coffee bar cabinetry. The large windows for the chapel arrived last week and will be installed shortly. It is unlikely we will break ground for the elevator this summer, but we hope to do so before winter. There are a number of supply chain issues involved in several aspects of the job. I met with nine different contractors this past week for different phases of the job and I am keeping the ball moving as best as possible. I assure you when the hall is completed, it will be one of the most beautiful church halls in the entire world. I mean that sincerely and without exaggeration.

Lastly, the new bell system arrived recently. We have not had an operating bell in approximately 20 years. I am hoping to have it ready for August 13, the feast day of Blessed Michael McGivney, though that may be a bit optimistic. The sound of the new digital bells will be stunning.

Thank you for all you do. I am so excited about our future. I have more wonderful news to share in the coming weeks, but cannot reveal it just yet. I will keep you in a little suspense!


