# From the desk of Fr. Sullivan

#### Dear friends,

The two photos below are from our fishing pilgrimage this past Saturday from Port of Galilee, Narragansett Bay RI. The majority of those fishing were from the Basilica, however I was delighted that several from St. Michael's also came. The weather was perfect and we all not only enjoyed fishing but each other's company as well.

As Catholics, especially in recent decades, we are not always known for our community activities. This is also true among almost every religious denomination. Television, technology, the Internet, texting instead of talking, etc., as good and useful as all of these are, have also caused us to become somewhat removed, even distant from each other. We get together with others less frequently and often interact more remotely.

In times past, especially at that time when so many of our ancestors came to America, it was the church that was the social center. We gathered together, worshiped together, played together, prayed together and we knew each other. It may seem like a small thing, but events like the fishing trip, the young adult camping trip, blessing of animals, rosary in the garden, and Vacation Bible school are all meant to bring people together. When we are together, truly enjoying each other's company in a way that is related to faith, we build each other up. When we think of church and worship and prayer, if at the same time we also think of our brothers and sisters and our enjoyment and love for them, faith fills us in a way that worshiping alone falls short.

Loving communities bring us joy and we all need that. In fact, humanity cannot live without joy.
