Eucharistic Revival

Just a few months ago, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops announced a "a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist"* The revival begins on the Feast of Corpus Christi, 2022, opening a Diocesan Year of Eucharistic Revival.

Corpus Christi 2023 opens a Parish Year of Eucharistic Revival. The third year begins with a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana from July 17-21, 2024 and concludes with a Year of Going Out on Mission.

Over the next several months, Orantes will reflect on various ways in which the Eucharistic Revival can be effectively observed in our Diocese during the coming years.

In the meantime, and in preparation for the opening of the Eucharistic Revival, we publish in this extended issue the USCCB document Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church, which was approved by the members of the Conference in November of 2021.

As a Diocesan Working Group on the Eucharistic Revival seeks ways to be supportive of Diocesan and Parish initiatives, pastors are encouraged to share the document with other parish leaders as the first step in our preparations to promote "a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—-and sent out in mission "for the life of the world.
