

When my mail arrives every day, I look forward to letters from our wonderful parishioners, but none cheers me more than when I read how much the faithful love their devoted priests. And as you know, almost all of them were educated and formed at *St. Joseph's Seminary and College*, Dunwoodie, now beginning its 130th year.

Our seminarians are not only the future shepherds of our flock, but they will also be spiritual guides and leaders in our wider communities. We must be sure that they are as well prepared as possible to serve the Church in New York. And for the last century and a quarter, Dunwoodie has been that place of formation. 



Saturdays from 4:00 to 4:45 pm. Anytime by






