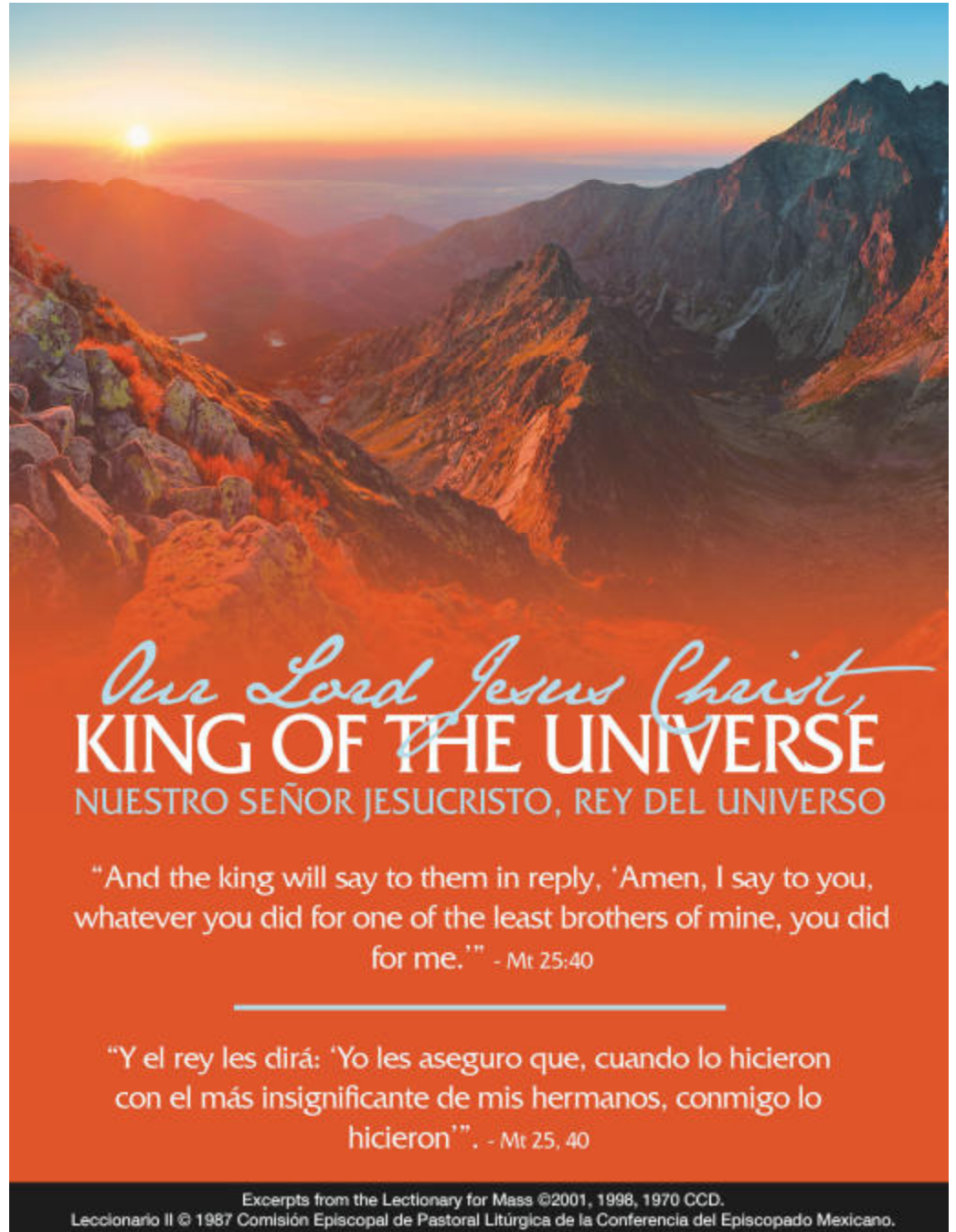

The Liturgical Year closes with the feast of Christ the King. In today's gospel, we hear about the final judgement at the end of time by the Son of Man, Jesus Christ, the King of the universe. Jesus Christ, the Good Shepherd, will separate "one from another, as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats." After the great separation, he gives to those on his right an inheritance. "Come, you who are blessed by my Father. Inherit the kingdom prepared from you from the foundation of the world." He welcomes those who lived the Beatitudes, who loved God with their all their heart, mind and strength, and who invested their talents in service to others. We see this theme repeated: The love of God is revealed through our love of neighbor. Our service to the King is measured by our service of others, especially those in need. As Christians, we show our love of God through our love of neighbor. As our relationship with Jesus Christ deepens, our desire to express that love is revealed in our sharing of our time or our wealth or our gifts with others. Jesus makes a profound statement to reflect upon always, *"whatever you did for one of the least brothers {or sisters} of mine, you did for me... [AND] what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me."* As a disciple of Christ, we cannot ignore the plight of others. We must have an awareness of the needs around us and do what we are capable. The Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy reveal to us concrete ways to reach out to those in need. I love this quote by Dorothy Day, "Everything a baptized person does, everyday, should be directly or indirectly related to the Corporal or Spiritual Works of Mercy. Let's strive to be sheep not goats."

On Thursday, our nation celebrates Thanksgiving Day. For all of us, this year has been extremely challenging and stressful. Our normal celebrations may be profoundly altered. Yet, we must take time to be grateful. We do this publicly as a country. Reflect on your year. What are you grateful for? May the gift of gratitude resound in our hearts and lives.

I am grateful to serve you as your pastor!

P.S. It is hard to believe but, next Sunday, the great season of Advent begins.

El año litúrgico se cierra con la fiesta de Cristo Rey. En el evangelio de hoy, escuchamos sobre el juicio final al final de los tiempos por el Hijo del Hombre, Jesucristo, el Rey del universo. Jesucristo, el Buen Pastor, separará "unos de otros, como un pastor separa las ovejas de las cabras". Después de la gran separación, les da una herencia a los de su derecha. "Venid, benditos de mi Padre. Hereda el reino preparado de ti desde la fundación del mundo ". Acoge a los que vivieron las Bienaventuranzas, que amaron a Dios con todo su corazón, mente y fuerzas, y que invirtieron sus talentos en el servicio a los demás. Vemos este tema repetido: el amor de Dios se revela a través del amor al prójimo. Nuestro servicio al Rey se mide por nuestro servicio a los demás, especialmente a los necesitados. Como Cristianos, mostramos nuestro amor a Dios a través de nuestro amor al prójimo. A medida que nuestra relación con Jesucristo se profundiza, nuestro deseo de expresar ese amor se revela al compartir nuestro tiempo o nuestra riqueza o nuestros dones con los demás. Jesús hace una declaración profunda sobre la que reflexionar siempre, *"todo lo que hiciste por uno de mis hermanos {o hermanas} más insignificantes, lo hiciste por mí... [Y] lo que no hiciste por uno de estos más insignificantes, no lo hiciste por mí."* Como discípulos de Cristo, no podemos ignorar la difícil situación de los demás. Debemos tener conciencia de las necesidades que nos rodean y hacer lo que somos capaces. Las Obras de Misericordia Corporales y Espirituales nos revelan formas concretas de llegar a los necesitados. Me encanta esta cita de Dorothy Day, "Todo lo que una persona bautizada hace, todos los días, debe estar directa o indirectamente relacionado con las Obras de Misericordia Corporales o Espirituales. Esforcémonos por ser ovejas, no cabras.

El Jueves, nuestra nación celebra el Día de Acción de Gracias. Para todos nosotros, este año ha sido extremadamente desafiante y estresante. Nuestras celebraciones normales pueden verse profundamente alteradas. Sin embargo, debemos tomarnos un tiempo para estar agradecidos. Hacemos esto públicamente como país. Reflexiona sobre tu año. ¿De qué estás agradecido? Que el don de la gratitud resuene en nuestros corazones y vidas.

NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, - *bow down* -

READING 1 EZ 34:11-12, 15-17

Thus says the Lord GOD: I myself will look after and tend my sheep. As a shepherd tends his flock when he finds himself among his scattered sheep, so will I tend my sheep. I will rescue them from every place where they were scattered when it was cloudy and dark. I myself will pasture my sheep; I myself will give them rest, says the Lord GOD. The lost I will seek out, the strayed I will bring back, the injured I will bind up, the sick I will heal, but the sleek and the strong I will destroy, shepherding them rightly. When did we see you ill or in prison, and visit you?' And the king will say to them in reply, 'Amen, I say to you, whatever you did for one of the least brothers of mine, you did for me.' Then he will say to those on his left, 'Depart from me, you accursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, a stranger and you gave me no welcome, naked and you gave me no clothing, ill and in prison, and you did not care for me.' Then they will answer and say, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill or in prison, and not minister to your needs?' He will answer them, 'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.' And these will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."

EVANGELIO Mt 25, 31-46
