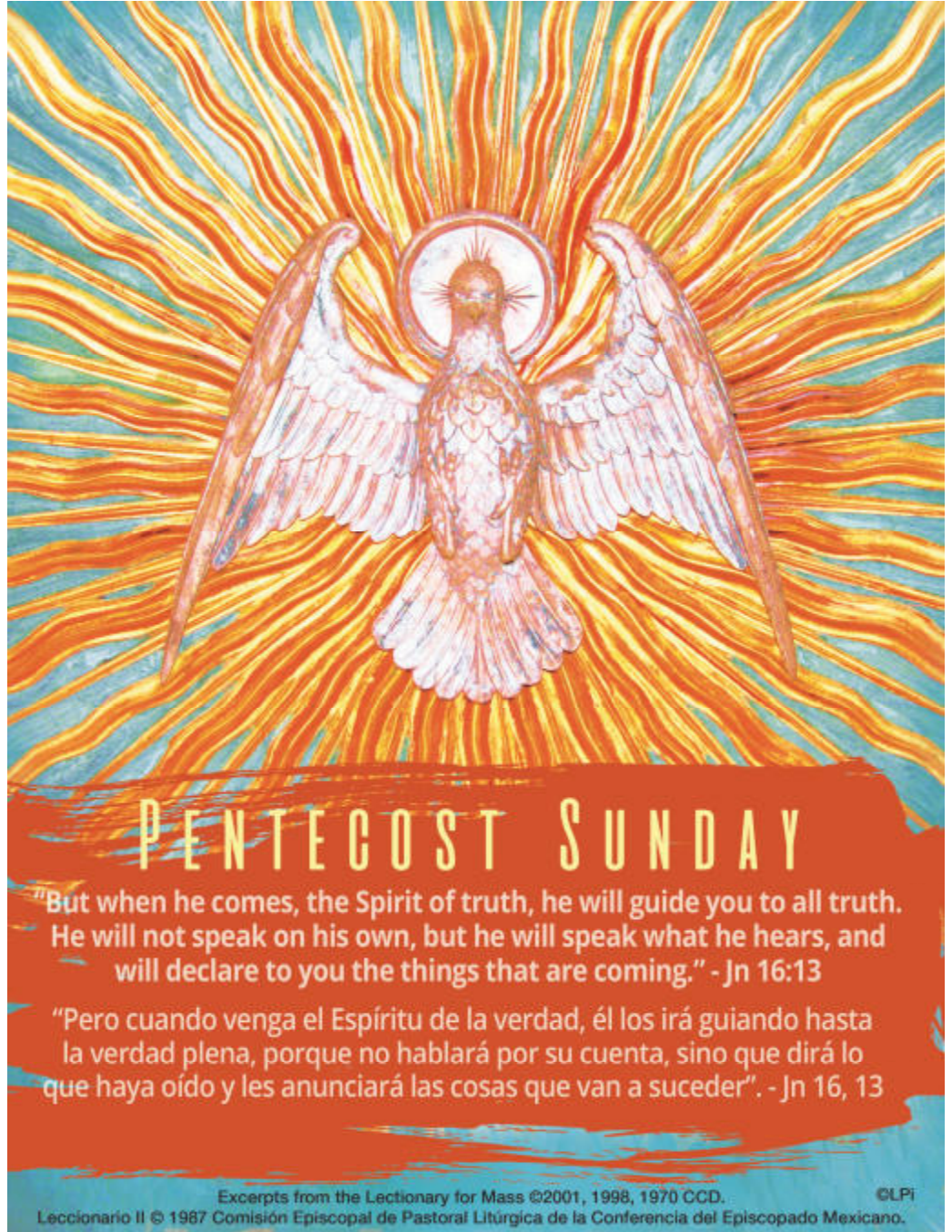

The Magnificat

My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord, My spirit rejoices in God my Savior for he has looked with favor on his lowly servant. From this day all generations will call me blessed: the Almighty has done great things for me, and holy is his Name. He has mercy on those who fear him in every generation. He has shown the strength of his arm, he has scattered the proud in their conceit. He has cast down the mighty from their thrones, and has lifted the lowly. He has filled the hungry with good things, and the rich he has sent away empty. He has come to the help of his servant Israel for he remembered his promise of mercy, the promise he made to our fathers, to Abraham and his children forever.

ORACIÓN PARROQUIAL MAYO

El Magnificat

Proclama mi alma la grandeza del Señor, se alegra mi espíritu en Dios mi Salvador, porque ha mirado la humillación de su esclava. Desde ahora me felicitarán todas las generaciones porque el Poderoso ha hecho obras grandes por mí. Su nombre es Santo y su misericordia llega a sus fieles de generación en generación. Él hace proezas con su brazo, dispersa a los soberbios de corazón. Derriba del trono a los poderosos y enaltece a los humildes. A los hambrientos los colma de bienes y a los ricos despide vacíos. Auxilia a Israel su siervo, acordándose de su santa alianza según lo había prometido a nuestros padres en favor de Abrahán y su descendencia por siempre.

Today is the great feast of Pentecost. We commemorate the promise of the Father, the Holy Spirit, upon the early Church community. They were given “power from on high.” They received gifts from God to fulfill the mission that was entrusted to them. Many people were “astounded and bewildered.” And others scoffed, “They have had too much new wine.” The celebration of Pentecost is not intended to be a reminder of an historical event. Rather, this mystery continues today. The Holy Spirit who enlivened the early Church community, is the same Holy Spirit who filled our souls at Baptism. The same Holy Spirit strengthens our bond to Jesus and his Church at Confirmation. The same Spirit guides and protects our Church community.

As a parish, your pastor is embarking on a new mission. He will be asked to shepherd two parishes. It is an impossible task **IF** I rely on my own power. However, with the guidance of the Holy Spirit and the cooperation of the people of both parishes, we can flourish. I think of the small size of the early Church community but look how it grew and multiplied. I have been entrusted with the responsibility of being a shepherd to the people of Easton. Pray to the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit inspires, animates and guides his Church. I have been praying a Novena to the Holy Spirit for a great outpouring of the presence of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is always active, yet, we must be open to receive and to cooperate with the Holy Spirit. If we have received Confirmation, we have a whole “tool kit” residing within us. We have the gifts of Wisdom, Understanding, Knowledge, Fortitude, Counsel, Piety and Fear of the Lord. We, too, receive “power from on high.” We, too, have gifts from God which were given to fulfill the mission entrusted to us.

Every morning ask the Holy Spirit to stir into flame the gifts that we have received. Each morning we look forward to the new adventure that God provides. Jesus promises us, “I will not leave you orphans.”

The Father never abandons his children. This is our confidence and hope.

Hoy es la gran fiesta de Pentecostés. Conmemoramos la promesa del Padre, el Espíritu Santo, sobre la comunidad de la Iglesia primitiva. Se les dio "poder de lo alto". Recibieron dones de Dios para cumplir la misión que les fue encomendada. Mucha gente estaba "asombrada y desconcertada". Y otros se burlaron: "Han bebido demasiado vino nuevo". La celebración de Pentecostés no pretende ser un recordatorio de un evento histórico. Más bien, este misterio continúa hoy. El Espíritu Santo que animó a la comunidad de la Iglesia primitiva, es el mismo Espíritu Santo que llenó nuestras almas en el Bautismo. El mismo Espíritu Santo fortalece nuestro vínculo con Jesús y su Iglesia en la Confirmación. El mismo Espíritu guía y protege a nuestra comunidad eclesial. Como parroquia, su párroco se está embarcando en una nueva misión. Se le pedirá que pastoree dos parroquias. Es una tarea imposible **SI** confío en mi propio poder. Sin embargo, con la guía del Espíritu Santo y la cooperación de la gente de ambas parroquias, podemos prosperar. Pienso en el pequeño tamaño de la comunidad de la Iglesia primitiva, pero mire cómo creció y se multiplicó. Se me ha confiado la responsabilidad de ser pastor de la gente de Easton. Ore al Espíritu Santo. El Espíritu Santo inspira, anima y guía a su Iglesia. He estado rezando una Novena al Espíritu Santo para un gran derramamiento de la presencia del Espíritu Santo. NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. READING 1 ACTS 2:1-11

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language.

They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We are Parthians, Medes, and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene, as well as travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism, Cretans and Arabs, yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God."

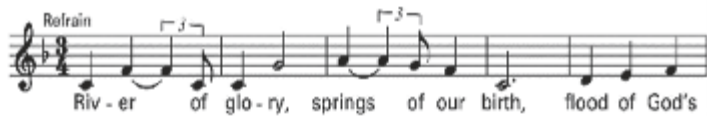

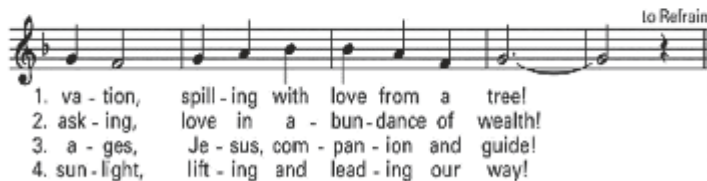

AS WE TRANSITION TO THE NEW SEASON AND RE-OPENING FURTHER, we must continue to be mindful of civil guidance and continued vigilance to ensure the safety and well-being of our communities.

As a reminder, effective Pentecost Sunday: 1. Exchange of the Sign of Peace/Distribution of the Precious Blood will remain suspended. 2. Sanitizer must still be regularly used, especially before/after the distribution of Holy Communion. 3. The Sunday Mass Obligation in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania remains suspended.

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania adopted the following recommendations, effective immediately.

The fully vaccinated may attend Masses in the Diocese of Allentown and all gatherings on parish property without wearing a mask. "Fully vaccinated" is defined as being 2 weeks after receiving the final dose of the vaccine. People who do not meet those requirements are not considered fully vaccinated, and must keep taking all precautions.
