The most challenging aspect of the spiritual life is to trust and hope and believe in a loving God in the midst of tremendous sorrow, suffering, pain, turmoil, or disappointment. It is relatively easy to give God credit when the storm has passed, after some struggle is over. Thank you God for taking away the difficult situation!

Faith, on the other hand, invites us and challenges us to trust and hope and have an interior peace even when we are in the midst of a storm, even when times are tough, even when the cross we are being asked to carry seems too heavy to bear. Faith, it seems (if we can trust what Jesus is implying) isn't giving God credit when things go our way. It is more about trusting even when they don't.

In this adventure that we call life, each of us will experience storms. I don't have to tell you that. Faith helps us understand that God is not absent from these storms. Rather, he is right in the middle of them - accompanying us, sustaining us, guiding us, and even wiping away our tears.

In a very real sense, Jesus is not IN the boat, he IS the boat, that place of safety and refuge which will carry us over the waves that might be endangering us or crushing our spirits. The challenges of life will continually come our way and often test what we believe and how deeply we believe it. Faith assures us that we are never alone. Jesus Christ is really present to us always.

May each of us pray for the grace to not let the tough times get the best of us. Rather, when we find ourselves facing a storm; whether physical, spiritual, or emotional may we continue to trust and hope and believe that our God is right there with us, and that (in ways we can't fully understand) everything will ultimately be ok; because God loves us that much. Terrified? Not when we put our faith in the One who can keep us safe.

¡El aspecto más desafiante de la vida espiritual es confiar y esperar y creer en un Dios amoroso en medio de una tremenda tristeza, sufrimiento, dolor, confusión o desilusión. Es relativamente fácil darle crédito a Dios cuando la tormenta ha pasado, después de que ha pasado alguna lucha. ¡Gracias a Dios por solucionar la difícil situación!

La fe, en cambio, nos invita y desafía a la confianza, la esperanza y la paz interior incluso cuando estamos en medio de una tormenta, incluso en tiempos difíciles, incluso cuando la cruz que se nos pide que carguemos parece demasiado pesado de soportar. Parece que la fe (si podemos confiar en lo que Jesús está insinuando) no es darle crédito a Dios cuando las cosas salen como queremos. Se trata más de confiar incluso cuando no lo hacen.

En esta aventura que llamamos vida, todos viviremos tormentas. No tengo que decirles esto. La fe nos ayuda a comprender que Dios no está ausente de estas tormentas. Más bien, él está justo en medio de nosotros, acompañándonos, sosteniéndonos, guiándonos e incluso secándonos las lágrimas.

En un sentido muy real, Jesús no está EN la barca, él ES la barca, ese lugar de seguridad y refugio que nos llevará sobre las olas que podrían ponernos en peligro o aplastar nuestros espíritus. Los desafíos de la vida vendrán continuamente en nuestro camino y, a menudo, probarán lo que creemos y cuán profundamente lo creemos. La fe nos asegura que nunca estamos solos. "Fully vaccinated" is defined as being 2 weeks after receiving the final dose of the vaccine. People who do not meet those requirements are not considered fully vaccinated, and must keep taking all precautions.
