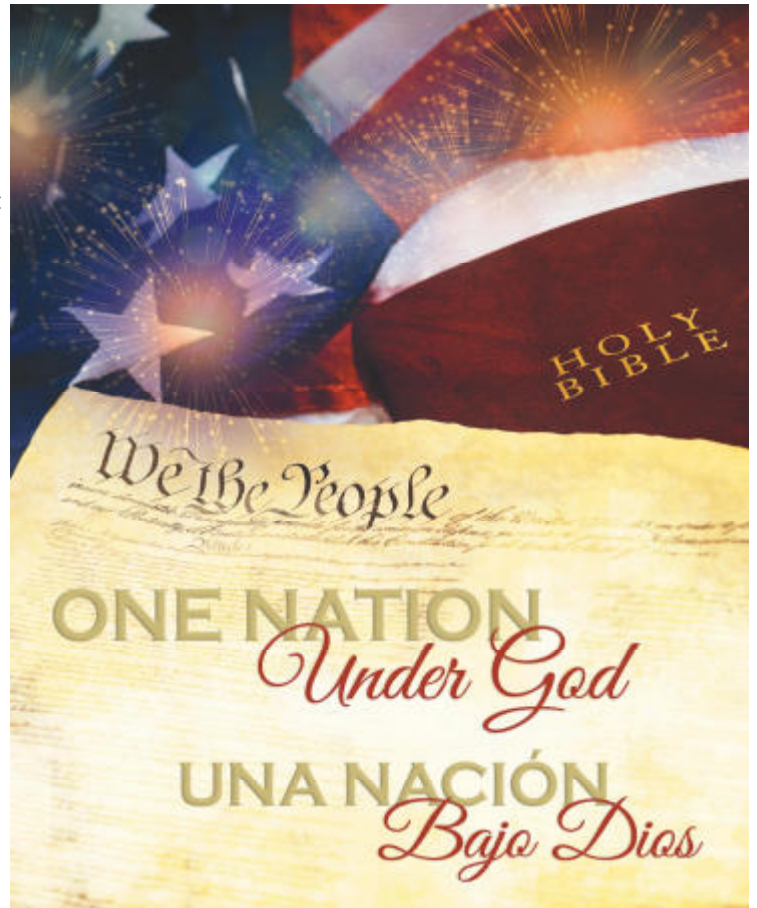

How could the people of Nazareth not believe Jesus is the Messiah? This might be an easy question that we ask 2000 years later as we have a familiarity with the identity of Jesus. However, the people of Nazareth were filled with unbelief. “Where did this man get all of this? ... Is he not the carpenter, the Son of Mary?” The expectations and perceptions of Jesus prevented them from believing Him and accepting Him for who He is. One scholar referred to this scene of the Gospel as a revelation of the “extraordinary ordinariness” of the Son of God. She continues, “Jesus lived a life so lowly, unassuming, and unremarkable that the possibility that the omnipotent God was present in him was simply incomprehensible to many who know him.”

We are not too different from the people of Nazareth. We, too, can have an overly familiar view of Jesus. He was a great teacher. He was a miracle worker. He was a kind man to everyone. What we often forget is that Jesus is the Son of God. The infinite God humbled himself to enter into his own world to rescue and save us in the person of Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is a unique person of all history. He is not a great human being. Rather, Jesus Christ is both God and man. His divinity is hidden within his humanity. Jesus has entered our world. He is present to us. But without the gift of faith, we can miss his presence. Our expectations and unbelief can prevent us from recognizing his daily presence. First and foremost, Jesus is present uniquely in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. The voice of Jesus is heard when the Gospels are read. And in a very unique way, Jesus is present among us in our daily events. Do you believe this? Reflect on this, how have you experienced the presence of Jesus in your life? How might you experience Jesus this week?

As we celebrate the birthday of our nation, thank God for the blessings and freedoms we have been given. Ask our Lord, to guide us to use those freedoms to respect the dignity of every person we encounter.

¿Cómo es posible que la gente de Nazaret no crea que Jesús es el Mesías? Esta podría ser una pregunta fácil que nos hacemos 2000 años después, ya que estamos familiarizados con la identidad de Jesús. Sin embargo, la gente se llenó de incredulidad. “¿De dónde sacó este hombre todo esto? ... ¿No es el carpintero, el Hijo de María?” Las expectativas y percepciones de Jesús les impidieron creer en Él y aceptarlo tal como es. Un erudito se refirió a esta escena del Evangelio como una revelación de la “extraordinaria ordinariedad” del Hijo de Dios. Ella continúa, “Jesús vivió una vida tan humilde, sin pretensiones y sin complicaciones que la posibilidad de que el Dios omnipotente estuviera presente en él era simplemente incomprensible para muchos que lo conocen”.

No somos muy diferentes a la gente de Nazaret. Nosotros también podemos tener una visión demasiado familiar de Jesús. Él fue un gran profesor. Él era un hacedor de milagros. Era un hombre amable con todos. Lo que olvidamos a menudo es que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios. El Dios infinito se humilló para entrar en su propio mundo para rescatarnos y salvarnos en la persona de Jesucristo. Jesucristo es una persona única en toda la historia. No es un gran ser humano. Más bien, Jesucristo es tanto Dios como hombre. Su divinidad está oculta dentro de su humanidad. Jesús ha entrado en nuestro mundo. Él está presente para nosotros. Pero sin el don de la fe, podemos perder su presencia. Nuestras expectativas e incredulidad pueden impedirnos reconocer su presencia diaria. En primer lugar, Jesús está presente únicamente en el Sacramento de la Sagrada Eucaristía. La voz de Jesús se escucha cuando se leen los Evangelios. Y de una manera muy singular, Jesús está presente entre nosotros en nuestros eventos diarios. ¿Cree usted esto? Reflexiona sobre esto, ¿cómo has experimentado la presencia de Jesús en tu vida? ¿Cómo experimentarías a Jesús esta semana?

Al celebrar el cumpleaños de nuestra nación, agradezcamos a Dios por las bendiciones y libertades que se nos han dado. Pídale a nuestro Señor que nos guíe a usar esas libertades para respetar la dignidad de cada persona que encontremos.

AS WE TRANSITION TO THE NEW SEASON AND RE-OPENING FURTHER,

we must continue to be mindful of civil guidance and continued vigilance to ensure the safety and well-being of our communities. As a reminder, effective Pentecost Sunday: 1. Exchange of the Sign of Peace/Distribution of the Precious Blood will remain suspended. 2. Sanitizer must still be regularly used, especially before/after the distribution of Holy Communion. 3. The Sunday Mass Obligation in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania remains suspended. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania adopted the following recommendations, effective immediately. The fully vaccinated may attend Masses in the Diocese of Allentown and all gatherings on parish property without wearing a mask. "Fully vaccinated" is defined as being 2 weeks after receiving the final dose of the vaccine. People who do not meet those requirements are not considered fully vaccinated, and must keep taking all precautions.
