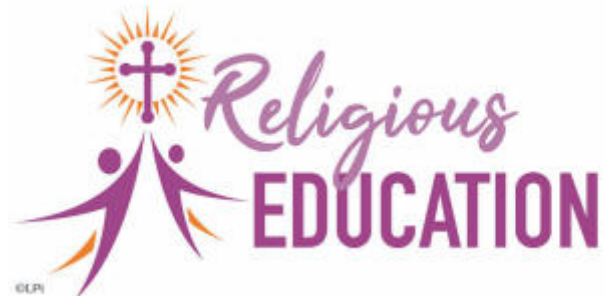

Have you heard about the Synod on Synodality? Synod is an ancient word which means "journeying together." It includes listening to the Holy Spirit and to each other in order to discern the path we are called to work together. Throughout Church history, there have been numerous Synods where the Bishops from around the world discern and reflect on various topics in the Church. Pope Francis has called a Synod 2021-2023: For a Synodal Church. This process has begun in October 2021 and will culminate in 2023 in Rome. In essence, this Synod is gathering reflections from all Baptized Catholics about their experience of the Church in their local parishes and communities. This not only includes regular Church goers, but, we want to reach out to those individuals who may no longer be practicing their faith. We want to listen to individuals who may feel excluded or marginalized from the Catholic Church. In other words, Pope Francis wants to hear from the whole Church. Perhaps you know someone that you can reach out to; invite them to participate in the Synod process. All of us must reflect on this question, how well do we really listen to one another?

The first phase of this Synod is on the local level. Throughout the Diocese of Allentown, there are over 200 Ambassadors who represent the various parishes. St. Anthony and Our Lady of Mercy will be hosting listening sessions in late January and Early February. These sessions allow for people to be listened to and heard. The Ambassador's will compile the fruit of these listening sessions throughout the Diocese of Allentown. Each Diocese will present their findings to their regional Bishops Conference and each Regional conference will present their findings to the Global synod in 2023.

This multi-step process is an amazing process. The Synod "is intended to inspire people to dream about the Church we are called to be, to make people's hopes flourish, to stimulate trust, to bind up wounds, to weave new and deeper relationships, to learn from one another, to build bridges, to enlighten minds, warm hearts, and restore strength to our hands for our common mission." One basic question is: What is the Holy Spirit saying to our Church today? For more information, I encourage you to go to our parish website and you can find additional information about dates and times for listening sessions at our parish or other parishes throughout the diocese. There is also a link for an online survey if you wish to participate in this process without attending a listening session. Let your voice be heard! We want to hear from you! It is my prayer that this process, if we engage it, will allow us to strengthen our listening heart. Listening to the Holy Spirit and listening to our brothers and sisters, we can all journey together in our walk with God.

¿Ha oído hablar del Sínodo sobre Sinodalidad? Sínodo es una palabra antigua que significa "viajar juntos". Incluye escuchar al Espíritu Santo y a los demás para discernir el camino en el que estamos llamados a trabajar juntos. A lo largo de la historia de la Iglesia, ha habido numerosos Sínodos en los que los Obispos de todo el mundo disciernen y reflexionan sobre diversos temas de la Iglesia. El Papa Francisco ha convocado un Sínodo 2021-2023: Por una Iglesia sinodal. Este proceso ha comenzado en octubre de 2021 y culminará en 2023 en Roma. En esencia, este Sínodo está reuniendo reflexiones de todos los católicos bautizados sobre su experiencia de la Iglesia en sus parroquias y comunidades locales. Esto no solo incluye a los asistentes habituales a la Iglesia, sino que queremos llegar a aquellas personas que quizás ya no practiquen su fe. Queremos escuchar a las personas que pueden sentirse excluidas o marginadas de la Iglesia Católica. En otras palabras, el Papa Francisco quiere escuchar a toda la Iglesia. Quizás conozca a alguien con quien pueda comunicarse; invítelos a participar en el proceso del Sínodo. Todos debemos reflexionar sobre esta pregunta, ¿qué tan bien nos escuchamos realmente unos a otros? La primera fase de este Sínodo es a nivel local. En toda la Diócesis de Allentown, hay más de 200 Embajadores que representan a las diversas parroquias. St. Anthony y Nuestra Señora de la Merced ofrecerán sesiones de escucha a fines de enero y principios de febrero. Estas sesiones permiten que la gente sea escuchada y escuchar. El Embajador recopilará el fruto de estas sesiones de escucha en toda la Diócesis de Allentown. Cada Diócesis presentará sus hallazgos a su Conferencia de Obispos regional y cada Conferencia Regional presentará sus hallazgos al Sínodo Global en 2023. Este proceso de varios pasos es un proceso asombroso. El Sínodo "tiene como objetivo inspirar a las personas a soñar con la Iglesia que estamos llamados a ser, hacer florecer las esperanzas de las personas, estimular la confianza, vendar heridas, tejer relaciones nuevas y más profundas, aprender unos de otros, construir puentes. , para iluminar mentes, calentar corazones y restaurar la fuerza en nuestras manos para nuestra misión común ". Una pregunta básica es: ¿Qué le está diciendo el Espíritu Santo a nuestra Iglesia hoy? Para obtener más información, le animo a que visite el sitio web de nuestra parroquia y podrá encontrar información adicional sobre las fechas y horarios de las sesiones de escucha en nuestra parroquia o en otras parroquias de la diócesis. También hay un enlace para una encuesta en línea si desea participar en este proceso sin asistir a una sesión de escucha. ¡Deja que se escuche tu voz! ¡Queremos escuchar de ti! Es mi oración que este proceso, si lo emprendemos, nos permita fortalecer nuestro corazón que escucha. Al escuchar al Espíritu Santo y escuchar a nuestros hermanos y hermanas, todos podemos caminar juntos en nuestro caminar con Dios.

Part 2 looks at the Liturgy and the 7 Sacraments. Part 3 explains the moral teaching looking at the Beatitudes and the 10 commandments. Part 4 reflects on Prayer looking at the Our Father. The Catechism is filled with Sacred Scripture, quotes of the Saints, Church documents and great explanations of our Catholic Faith.
