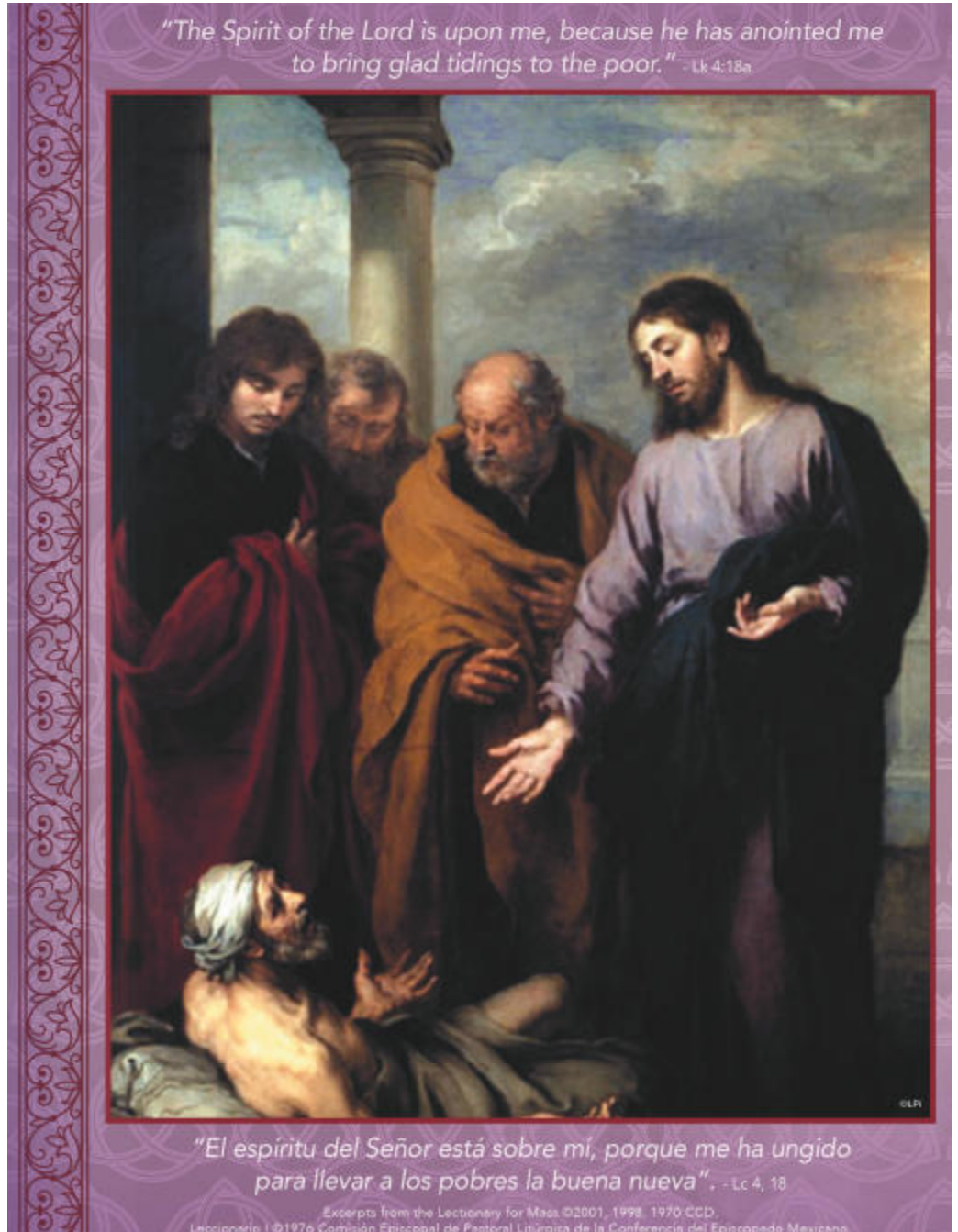

“Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing.” In today’s Gospel, Jesus reads from the scroll of Isaiah which we refer to as the Old Testament. Jesus’ words teach us a very important truth about the Scriptures. Jesus is the fulfillment of the Old Testament. The books that we refer to as the Old Testament were the Scriptures of Jesus and the early Church. Early Christian teaching used the Old Testament to explain the Faith. Sometimes it is easy to dismiss the Old Testament and only be interested in the New Testament. There is an ancient saying, “The New Testament lies hidden in the Old and the Old Testament is unveiled in the New.” The Church uses this principle when it presents the Sunday readings. Every Sunday Mass, there is always a connection between the Old Testament reading and the Gospel. Can you see the connection for this Sunday’s readings?

At every Sunday Mass, we are fed from two tables – the table of the Word and the table of the Eucharist. In 2019, Pope Francis named the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time as Word of God Sunday. It is devoted to the celebration and study of the Word of God. I encourage you to read a small portion of the Bible every day. For example, reading the Sunday readings for the upcoming Sunday is a great way to digest the Word of God before you come to Sunday Mass. A great tool that I use is the AMEN app. You can listen to the daily readings and brief reflections are included. Reflecting on the Word of God prepares us for a deeper encounter with the Word made Flesh – Jesus Christ.

This Friday, January 28, we begin the friendly competition and fundraiser called “Cooks with Collars.” Last year, we raised over \$5,000 for each of our parishes. The advertising sponsors raise money for Catholic Charities. This year, because I am the pastor of two Churches, I was asked to prepare two separate recipes. For St. Anthony’s, I prepared *Pasta Ceci*. For Our Lady of Mercy, I prepared *Bridget’s Scottish Shortbread*. I hope you enjoy the videos. “Hoy mismo se ha cumplido este pasaje de la Escritura que acaban de oír”. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús lee del rollo de Isaías al que nos referimos como el Antiguo Testamento. Las palabras de Jesús nos enseñan una verdad muy importante acerca de las Escrituras. Jesús es el cumplimiento del Antiguo Testamento. Los libros a los que nos referimos como el Antiguo Testamento eran las Escrituras de Jesús y la Iglesia primitiva. La enseñanza cristiana primitiva usaba el Antiguo Testamento para explicar la fe. A veces es fácil descartar el Antiguo Testamento y solo interesarse en el Nuevo Testamento. Hay un dicho antiguo: “El Nuevo Testamento está escondido en el Antiguo y el Antiguo Testamento está descubierto en el Nuevo”. La Iglesia usa este principio cuando presenta las lecturas dominicales. Cada Misa dominical, siempre hay una conexión entre la lectura del Antiguo Testamento y el Evangelio. ¿Puedes ver la conexión para las lecturas de este domingo?

En cada Misa Dominical, nos alimentamos de dos mesas: la mesa de la Palabra y la mesa de la Eucaristía. En 2019, el Papa Francisco nombró el tercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario como Domingo de la Palabra de Dios. Está dedicada a la celebración y estudio de la Palabra de Dios. Te animo a leer una pequeña porción de la Biblia todos los días. Por ejemplo, leer las lecturas Dominicales del próximo Domingo es una excelente manera de digerir la Palabra de Dios antes de venir a la Misa Dominical. Una excelente herramienta que uso es la AMEN app. Se pueden escuchar las lecturas diarias y se incluyen breves reflexiones. Reflexionar sobre la Palabra de Dios nos prepara para un encuentro más profundo con el Verbo hecho Carne: Jesucristo.

Este viernes 28 de enero, iniciamos la competencia amistosa y benéfica denominada “Cooks with Collars.” El año pasado recaudamos más de \$5000 para cada una de nuestras parroquias. Los patrocinadores de la publicidad recaudan fondos para Caridades Católicas. Este año porque soy pastor de dos Iglesias. Me pidieron que preparara dos recetas separadas. Para San Antonio preparé *Pasta Ceci*. Para Nuestra Señora de la Misericordia preparé *Bridget’s Scottish Shortbread*. Espero que disfrutes los videos. Los invito a participar generosamente ya que todos los fondos recaudados van directamente a la parroquia. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) is an in-depth summary of the Catholic Faith. It is divided into 4 parts. Part 1 explains what we believe using the Creed as an outline. Part 2 looks at the Liturgy and the 7 Sacraments. Part 3 explains the moral teaching looking at the Beatitudes and the 10 commandments. Part 4 reflects on Prayer looking at the Our Father. The Catechism is filled with Sacred Scripture, quotes of the Saints, Church documents and great explanations of our Catholic Faith. REFLECTION

Are family bonds an absolute good?

Family ties are important but not absolute, because the first vocation of a Christian is to follow Jesus and love him: "He who loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me" (Matthew 10:37). Parents must support with joy their children's choice to follow Jesus in whatever state of life, even in the consecrated life or the priestly ministry.
