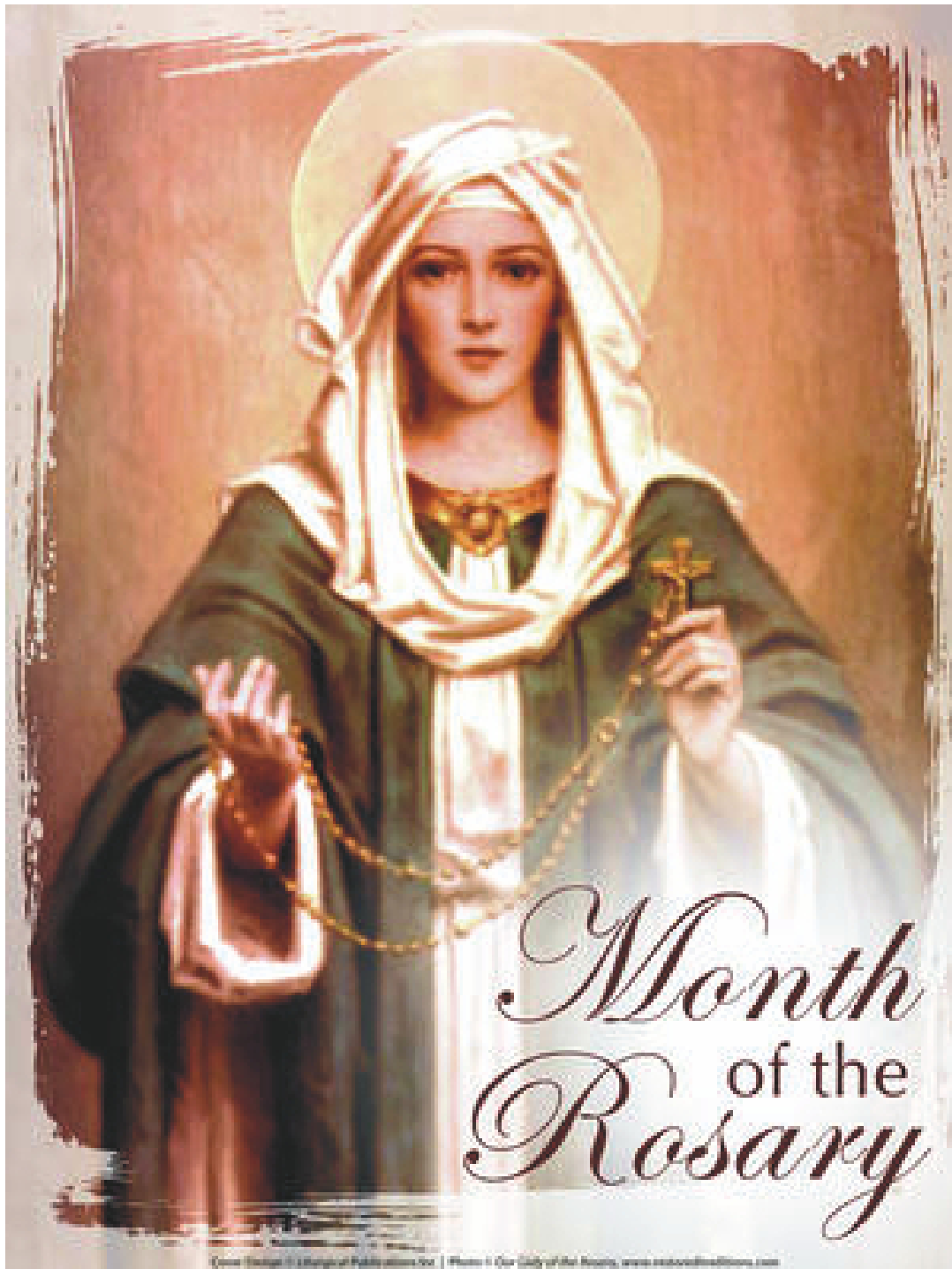

REFLECTION

THE 29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY
TIME (World Mission Sunday)

First Reading: Isaiah 45:1, 4-6

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 96:1, 3, 4-5, 7-8,
9-10

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1:1-5b

Gospel Reading: Matthew 22:15-21

Reflection: On this World Mission Sunday, I remind myself that I have been called by the virtue of my baptism to carry the Gospel of Christ to the ends of the world. We are all missionaries. The human arrogance continues to blind us to see the reality/truth. We see and elevate the creation and fail to see the creator. We enjoy the wines and fail to recognize the vine and the vineyard.

We cling to branches and fail to recognize the trunk and the roots which carry the branches. In short, human arrogance leads us to see the parts and fail to see the whole. In the First Reading, God reminds his anointed, Cyrus that, "I have called you by your name, giving you a title . . . It is I who arm you, though you know me not."

When Pharisees ask Jesus a treacherous question if it is lawful to pay the census tax to Caesar or not? Jesus asks the Pharisees as to whose image is on the coin? As they respond that the coin carries Caesar's image, he concludes: Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God." In the Second Reading Paul is praising the Thessalonians for their faith in God as he writes, "and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God and to await his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus, who delivers us from the coming wrath." To gain maturity in life, we are called to do things right: to repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God. We need to know that we have full responsibility to matters of this world and also full responsibility to matters of God and matters of God come first. Yes we are missionaries. Yes! Amen!

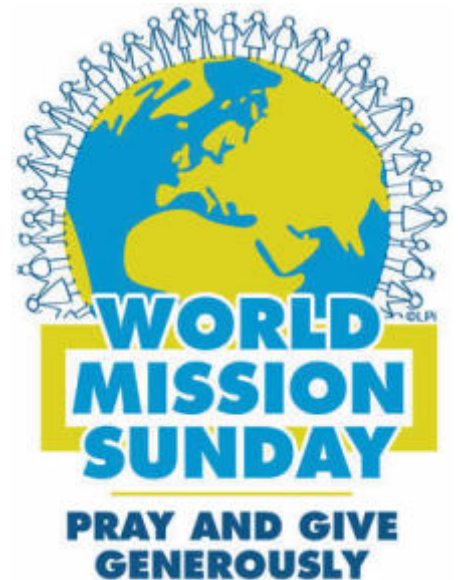

Give to God
In today's Gospel, the Pharisees pose a trick question to Jesus, "Is it better to pay the tribute tax to Caesar or not?" Jesus did not fall for the legal trap. Jesus notes that the coin has the image of Caesar and therefore, it belongs to Caesar. But, more importantly, Jesus also said "to give to God what belongs to God." Just as the Roman coin bears the image of the Emperor who made it, so the human soul bears the image and likeness of God (Genesis 1:26) of God who calls each of us into existence so as to live in personal communion with Him. "Claring from God, going toward God, man lives a fully human life only if he freely lives by his bond with God" (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 44).

The Bible says that we were created by God and that we were created in the image of God. If we are created by God, and we were created in His image, we must belong to Him. That means we must give ourselves to Him.

Family Activity: Gather loose coins around the house - under the sofa cushions, in the car, the bottom of your pants, etc. Sort the coins and talk about the images of those on the coins. Then, have each family member create a "coin" on paper with a self portrait (or use a photo). Let each family member say "give of themselves" to God. Count and roll coins to use as an offering either at church or for another charity such as your local food bank.

Dear Father, you created us in your image and we belong to you. Because of that, we give our hearts and lives to you. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

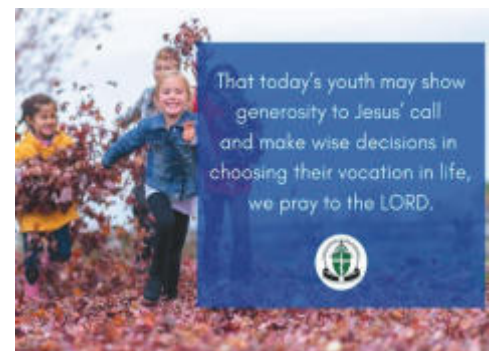
