## **ADVENT & CHRISTMAS WITH OUR LADY**

During the holy seasons of Advent and Christmas, we invite you to join with Our Blessed Mother in the expectation and the birth of Jesus Christ. There are many great feasts of hers in the Church's calendar during these holy days, each one with its own particular character, and each one revealing a different aspect of Mary's love and obedience to the will of God.

#### DECEMBER 10TH - OUR LADY OF LORETO

This feast of Our Lady commemorates the miraculous translation of the holy house where the Blessed Virgin Mary was conceived and born in Nazareth, to Loreto, a small town in northeastern Italy. This is the same house where the Archangel Gabriel appeared to Our Lady at the Annunciation and where Jesus was conceived. This same house was witness to the daily life of the Holy Family, and the death of Saint Joseph.

In 1291, when the Saracens invaded the Holy Land and expelled the remaining Christians from the country, the entire house was miraculously transported from Nazareth to Dalmatia, and three years later was miraculously transported again to Loreto. To this day, pilgrims from all over the world visit this tiny house, enshrined within the Basilica della Santa Casa in Loreto. The authenticity of this most holy dwelling has been verified over centuries by architectural and archeological researchers, as well as by ecclesiastical authorities. On October 7, 2019, Pope Francis ordered the inscription of the Memorial of Our Lady of Loreto into the General Roman Calendar on the tenth of December.

Virgin most prudent, Virgin most venerable, Virgin most renowned, Virgin most powerful, Virgin most merciful, Virgin most faithful, pray for us.

Mirror of justice, Seat of wisdom, Cause of our joy, Spiritual vessel, Vessel of honor, Singular vessel of devotion, Mystical rose, Tower of David, Tower of ivory, House of gold, Ark of the covenant, Gate of Heaven, Morning star, Health of the sick, Refuge of sinners, Solace of migrants, Comforter of the afflicted, Help of Christians, pray for us.

## Saint of the Week



#### Monday, December 27th - St. John, Apostle & Evangelist

Saint John was born near the Sea of Galilee in Israel. He was the son of Zebedee and Mary Salome, who was a kinswoman of Our Lady. He was a fisherman and the brother of Saint James the Greater. These two brothers were called 'Boanerges' (the 'sons of thunder') by Jesus because of their fervor in serving Him, and their willingness to follow and defend Him.

Saint John was first a disciple of Saint John the Baptist, and he and Saint Andrew were the men who followed Jesus after His Baptism. He was the youngest of the Apostles and is usually shown in iconography without a beard. He was present at the raising of Jairus' daughter from the dead, at the Transfiguration on the top of the mountain, at the preparation of the Last Supper, and was a witness to Jesus' agony in the Garden of Gethsemane. Standing at Our Lady at the foot of the Cross, Saint John received Our Lady into his care when Jesus said to him "Behold your mother", and to Mary, "Behold your son". Following the death of Jesus, Saint John assisted in His burial, and witnessed the empty tomb on Easter morning along with Saint Peter. He was present in the Upper Room when Jesus appeared to the Apostles that evening and again on the shores of the Sea of Galilee for the miraculous catch of 153 fish.

After Jesus' Ascension, John was a pillar of the church in Jerusalem, preaching the Gospel in spite of threats and imprisonment. He moved to Ephesus where he wrote his Gospel and three epistles and was taken in 92 AD as a prisoner to Rome under the reign of the Emperor Domitian. He was condemned to death and plunged into cauldrons of boiling oil but emerged unharmed - this is commemorated in Rome at the chapel of San Giovanni in Oleo at the Latin Gate. He was then exiled to the island of Patmos where he wrote the Book of Revelation. After his death in the year 100, his body was taken to Ephesus for burial, and an immense basilica was built over his tomb in nearby Selcuk. His relics have never been found, nor has any city or local church claimed to possess them. This has led some to believe that he was assumed bodily into Heaven like Elijah. Saint John is the patron saint of love, loyalty, friendships, and authors. As one of the Gospel writers, he is often depicted in art with an eagle.

His image is located in our church along with the other three evangelists in the stained glass windows over the two side doors.

O God, who through the blessed Apostle John have unlocked for us the secrets of your Word, grant, we pray, that we may grasp with proper understanding what he has so marvelously brought to our ears. Through Christ Our Lord. Amen. (Collect for the Feast of St. John, Apostle & Evangelist)


