**Baptism:** Baptisms are celebrated monthly but must be scheduled weeks in advance. Active parishioners should contact your parish office to begin preparations.


Marriage: Diocesan requirements state that

arrangements should begin at least 6 months to one year before desired date of marriage. Active parishioners should contact the parish office for more details.



Today is the Solemnity of Pentecost, marking the end of the Easter season, also referred to as the birthday of the Church.

When the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples, they immediately began proclaiming the Gospel. The disciples, through the gift of the Holy Spirit, were answering Jesus' call to "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit". (Mt. 28:19) The Holy Spirit is vital in the mission and witness of the Church - we, the people. Today we celebrate the grace of being filled with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

On Pentecost, the Spirit was sent forth by the risen Christ, and all became different and set on fire! The Spirit came down on the first followers of Jesus, and also entered into the hearts of the listeners: all were enflamed with the experience of Jesus. We, like the first disciples are being called to live the gifts of the Holy Spirit in a radical way. We, as those disciples did, need to overcome our fears by remembering that through the indwelling Spirit, Jesus continues to guide and teach, comfort and challenge, defend and protect all of his followers.

Let's celebrate how much our God loves us and empowers us to follow in the ways of His beloved Son by living as His witnesses in the world.

At each LIFE celebration I leave our participants with a particular focus or challenge to go forth with. Here's my challenge for this day: May we, each one of us, recommit ourselves to seek the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives so to better proclaim the Gospel and build God's kingdom on earth always and all ways.


