LAUDATE DEUM

Pope Francis, in his letter Laudate Deum, stresses the urgency of addressing the climate crisis and acknowledges the irreversible harm already inflicted. He emphasizes that the crisis, a result of human actions, cannot be denied. However, he warns against relying solely on technology, asserting that power should be used to protect life, not just increasing for its own sake. The Pope criticizes economic powers for prioritizing profit over environmental care. He advocates for both individual actions and systemic political change, urging significant outcomes from the upcoming COP28 UN negotiations. Despite the dire situation, Pope Francis emphasizes the importance of maintaining hope, especially for the most vulnerable, a message that resonates deeply in parts of Africa.

Thank you very much for your continued love and support for our parish. We are especially grateful to those who “make up” for their Sundays away from the Parish.

MESSAGE FROM FR. WILLEM

Dear Parish family of St. Charles Borromeo, Resurrection and All Saints,

We are 135 years old. CONGRATULATIONS! CONGRATULATIONS! HAPPY FEAST!

A few weeks ago, we had the unique opportunity to celebrate during the Gospel Mass at St Charles Borromeo Church the 100th birthday of Iona Jenkins together with her family and friends. Our parishioners were filled with awe and joy to see this 'Grand Lady' in person thanking God for all the blessings in her life. Fr Bryan was filled with unbelief and emotion and blessed her graciously. Today, as parishioners of St Charles Borromeo, Resurrection and All Saints, we are also filled with happiness knowing that as a Parish we are even much older than 100 years having reached the incredible age of 135 years. This is a great milestone we cannot just let pass by without notice but one that we must celebrate with joy and in a Spirit of Thanksgiving. As originally two different Faith Communities, the members of St Charles and Resurrection churches have left over the many years until now an amazing mark on the neighborhood of Harlem and beyond. We love to be active in serving the Lord in various ministries which make a real difference in people's lives. We love to celebrate our faith with joy and, therefore, to praise and worship in unique ways that uplift our community. We love to find our strength in the Word of God and in the breaking of the one Bread which gives us new life and peace. We love to protect our own unique identity and to build upon all the successes that we have inherited from the past. We love to build a community where everyone, young and old, can feel welcome, loved, and accepted. There is still a lot of work to be done in the vineyard of the Lord and in our fast-changing world there are also lots of challenges ahead that we will have to face head on. One of the challenges that deserves urgent attention is that our physical Church structures are very old but not beyond repair and so we need to plan for the restoration of our church buildings. Our various parish ministries need some volunteers who can commit themselves and give new life to the parish. Please, therefore, I encourage and recommend you kindly after the Gospel Mass to sign up today in the Auditorium for one of the parish ministries if you feel called for the glory of God to share your gifts and talents with the wider community. But, of course, the primary ministry of all of us who have been baptized is to assemble each Sunday in our churches as we are called to give thanks to God and to participate fully, consciously, and actively in the celebration of the Eucharist.
