Out of the Crowd

In today's Gospel reading, Jesus attempts to educate the crowd and us concerning what our desires, our motivations, and our beliefs about Him ought to be. The crowds that followed Christ to the other side of the lake did so because He gave them food. They were not looking to deepen their understanding of themselves or their role in the world. They wanted to be followers of a great leader who would sustain them with an abundance of food.

Why do we follow Him?

Our motivations can be multiple because we find ourselves attracted to the goodness of God for different reasons. Some of us look for the peace and consolation of faith. Others try to make the world a more just and better place. Some seek a structure enabling them to manage their family life and the education of their children. These motivations are good in themselves. But there is one motivation that needs to crown all others. That desire is for God Himself. We need to teach ourselves to be ever closer to Him. In the way we think or act, in the way we speak and look at each other, we need to be Christ-like.

Christ is sent, given to us, so that we may flourish. He lives in us - this is what we must believe. He is coming back in glory - this is what we ought to desire. He left us His Good News and His Body and Blood to be shared around the world - this is what we should do.

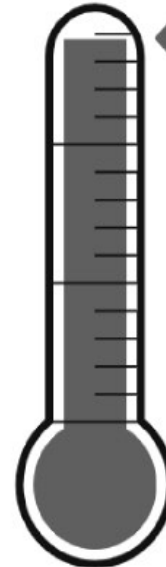

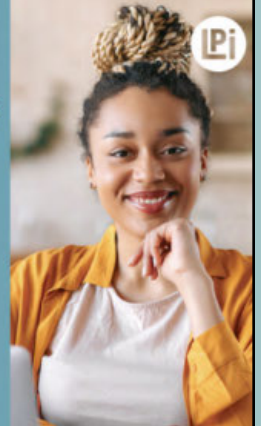

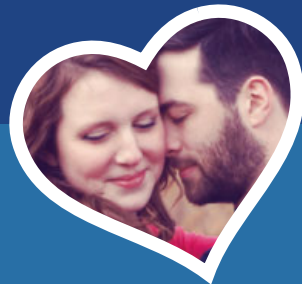
