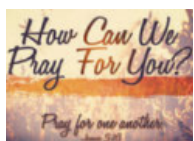

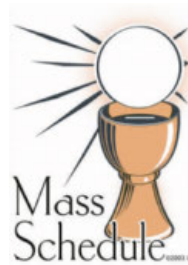

Marriages Couples planning to be married must make an appointment with the Pastor to set a wedding date and begin preparations at least **one year in advance**.

Responsorial Psalm ~ Psalm 90

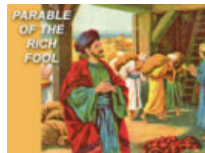
If today you hear your voice, harden not your hearts.
