FROM OUR PASTOR MSGR. CAMP



Dear Parishioners

One of the dreams of the early pastors of St. Patrick's was to have a Parish School. In 1922 under the leadership of Fr. Robinson and with the assistance of the Dominican Sisters from Amityville the School was opened. Like all things it did not go entirely as planned. The building was not yet complete in September 1922, so the students were in different locations around the Village. Finally on a very cold and snowy day in the winter of 1923 the students marched up Main Street to their new School building. This is essentially the same route the Annual St. Patrick Parade takes each year. The simple two floor square building has had numerous additions and alterations over the decades. Some of which have come back to haunt the current Pastor, which I call the 3 L's, leaks, locks and ledgers. In 1924 the first class graduated, and we have never looked back always moving forward. Through the generations the school curriculum has advanced to now where regents courses are offered and reading scores are the highest in the diocese.

This year our 100th Anniversary is tied to the Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade. In looking back at the history of the Village, the School and our Irish roots are intertwined. In 1933 the Irish American Social Club was established and in 1935 the first parade was held. In 1947 the Ancient Order of Hibernians created a division for Huntington and the parade was eventually undertaken by them. As the Huntington Irish Club had formed to protect Irish immigrants, after the first parish Church was burnt down on March 1, 1867, which had followed a previous attempt to burn down the Rectory on July 4, 1866, the AOH has worked not only to defend the Irish race from unjust attacks but to provide for the community in its time of need and bring compassion to our Town.

Over these past six years the Parish, the School and the Hibernians have created a great relationship of cooperation in helping the local community and its needs. Food and clothing drives, contributing to the Town Wide Fund, the Christmas Gift and Giving Program, and emergency needs as they arise.

The Ancient Order of Hibernians was founded to extol Irish heritage and American citizenship. Its motto is Faith, Unity and Christian Charity. Greg Kennedy, this year's Parade Grand Marshal, and AOH. Div 4, President Emeritus has been a leader in our community. He is currently the President of the Townwide Fund and a member of the Foundation Board of Directors of the Visiting Nurse Service and Hospice. His family, Church and community are essential aspects of his life.

St. Patrick's School has been served by Sr. Maureen McDade, RSM for twenty-five years. As principal the school has grown under her leadership and intuition. She knows every student by name and takes pride in handing each student their report card every trimester. Progressive in education and traditional in its values, St. Patrick's School thrives with all the contemporary methods of education and where the pledge of allegiance is said every day, prayer is offered each day with the students learning to reverence God and respect themselves and each other. The motto of the school; To Learn, Serve, Lead and Succeed is the value in which Catholic education has its roots and tradition, the Gospel of Christ.

Through the efforts of both Sr. Maureen and Greg Kennedy the best of Huntington is seen and celebrated. We are most honored to celebrate both individuals this weekend for they both share their faith and good works in all that we do and are better for their presence in our lives as they bring us forward to do more and live the value of Christian Charity.

When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal, and observed from age 18 until age 59.

The norms concerning abstinence from meat are observed by those from age 14 onwards.

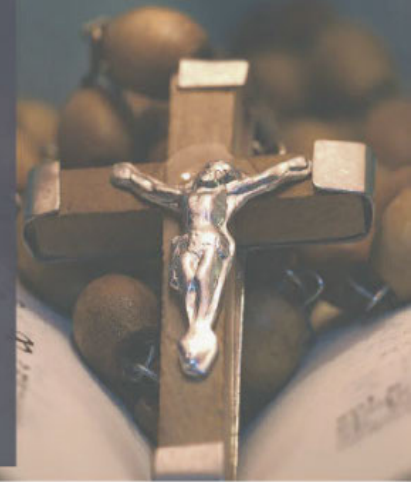

RE: **Saint Patrick's Day and the Obligation to Abstain from Eating Meat**

The holy Season of Lent is a time of spiritual preparation for the celebration of our Lord's passion, death, and resurrection at Easter, the holiest of days. Through prayer, fasting and works of charity, we draw closer to the Lord, deepen our faith, and prepare for eternal life.

The obligation of abstinence from meat on Fridays of Lent is an important element of the Church's observance of the penitential nature of this holy season. However, if you choose not to abstain from meat on March 17th (St. Patrick's Day), please substitute some other penance, prayer, and work of charity in its place.

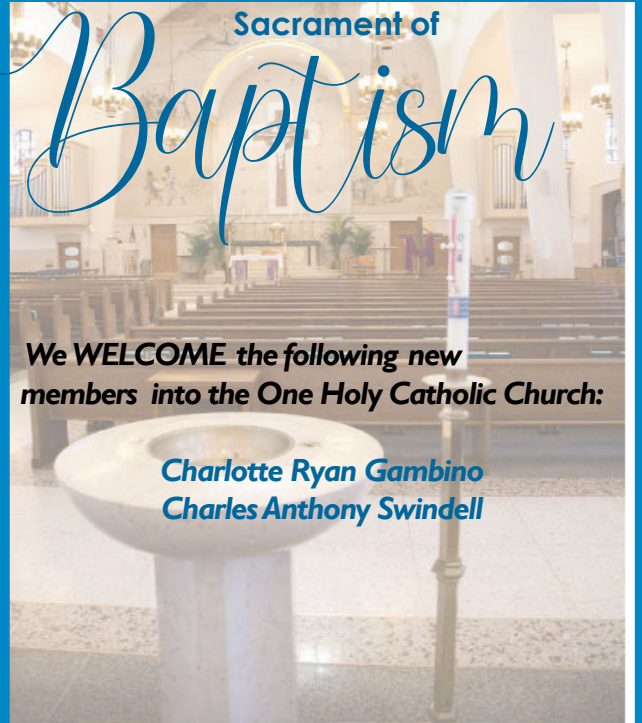

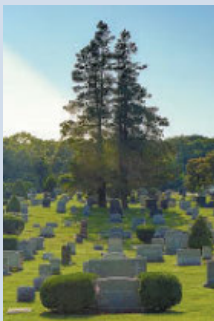
