Dear Parishioners,

I was remiss in thanking Mr. Matthew Koraus, our music director, for the spectacular musical celebration at the Mass. The adult and youth choirs were magnificent in their signing. The music added to a very special Mass, for a very grateful parish, the gift that our parish school has been for the past 100 years. Thank you to Bishop Coyle for celebrating the Mass with us and dedicating the 100th Anniversary Plaque.

Sr. Maureen and Mrs. Herr held a wonderful breakfast and gathering in the lower Church for all of those who participated. Thank you to the Staff, Teachers, volunteers, and Board Members who attended. It was nice to see so many students and their families as well as some of our distinguished alumni and parishioners. Now it's on to the next 100!

Religious Education classes have started and I am so happy to welcome back our many students and families. Mrs. Calabrese and the Staff have been working on some additions to the curriculum and events for this academic year. Grade level Masses have begun. Please make note of the schedule that is in the bulletin and a reminder that these Masses, in conjunction with the School Community, are an essential part of the faith formation program of all our students, regardless of which program the students are enrolled.

As October begins, we celebrate a month dedicated to the Rosary and Respect Life. Seminarian Patrick O'Brien is speaking at the end of all the Masses this weekend to discuss the addition of First Saturday devotions commencing on Saturday October 7th. Please consider spending time with the Lord through the intercession of His Mother, once per month, on the First Saturday.

Humility is the topic of this week's readings. Stubbornness and arrogance will only lead to frustration as we attempt to discern God's will. Humility will create a sense of openness to a way of life that we might not yet imagine. Humility helps us to look beyond our own conception of who we think God is. A Humble person sees life and how they fit into it. An arrogant person sees life as how they can manipulate others to get what they want. As a Christian we are called to see the needs of others and respond to that need. We must have the attitude of Christ in all that we do. It is about living a virtuous life.

Please look through the bulletin at the many parish and community events sponsored this fall. The Seminary is hosting Sundays at the Seminary focusing on The Holy Eucharist. We have Bishop Robert Barron's text on the call to Eucharistic Revival, *This Is My Body*, available on the tables, at the entrances to the Church. Bishop Barron offers a threefold analysis of the Eucharist as sacred meal, sacrifice, and Real Presence. We are hosting the Extraordinary Form (Latin) Votive Mass of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on October 6th at 7:30pm. On October 17th, Kevin Becker will be speaking at the parish. He credits the blessed Pierre Giorgio Frassati for saving his life, through a miracle recovery, after an injury. All are welcome. Have a good week.

FIRST SATURDAY DEVOTION

FIRST SATURDAY Devotion

Dear Parishioners of Saint Patrick's,

Starting Saturday October 7th, we will be starting the First Saturday Devotion to Our Lady that she asked for when she appeared in Fatima in 1917. This time of prayer with Jesus and Mary is in reparation for offenses against Our Blessed Mother, especially her Immaculate Conception, Perpetual Virginity, Divine Motherhood, as well as indifference and insults toward her or images of her.

The devotion has **FOUR PARTS:**

- 1) **Confession** (On First Saturday, or anytime the week before or after)
- 2) **Receive Holy Communion** (On First Saturday)
- 3) **Pray the Rosary:** Five Decades (One set of mysteries, on First Saturday)
- 4) **15 Minutes of silent meditation**, following the rosary on the mysteries of the rosary (Any 1 mystery or more)

Before the 8:30 am Mass on First Saturdays, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed at 8:00am, and the rosary will be prayed (with the addition of the "Fatima Prayer") in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, followed by 15 minutes of silent meditation. The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed right before Mass. (Confessions are available Saturdays at 4pm in the Church) (If it is a Saturday without a mandatory Memorial for Mass, then the 8:30 Mass will be a Votive Mass for the Blessed Virgin Mary)

Let us continue to pray for each other and for our parish family, especially that the Blessed Mother may lead us closer to Jesus and give us a greater love for Him, the Sacraments, and His Church! God Bless you.

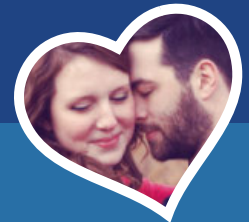
