


Gospel Meditation

February 19, 2023 7th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Of all the things Jesus says which seem totally bat-crazy, this one might take the cake: "But I say to you, love your enemies, and pray for those who persecute you." An enemy is someone who desires the destruction of you, your projects, or those you care about. To love and pray for them is to want their health,



strength, and flourishing. But if they thrive, they are more likely to hurt you and others. So, aren't you indirectly willing your own destruction, or that of your friends? If you doubt that this problem is embedded in this teaching, when was the last time you actually prayed honestly for the people you really hate?

How can we solve this riddle so we might actually live this command? Recall that enemy-love is the surest sign that you love someone with God's love, and not with indirect egotism. After all, if my love for my enemy ends up hurting me or my loved ones, it can't be for me. Enemy-love costs more because there are no tit-for-tats. No reciprocity — just loved poured out, and often pain in return. That's why it is so precious and rare. "What is unusual about that?" asks the Lord about love for our friends. Jesus wants us to experience the unusual love which only comes from him.

When Jesus was being killed on the cross, he was loving his executioners. In fact, he was holding them in being as they nailed him to the cross. He loved those who were spiritually piercing his Mother's heart, while they were doing it. And when he rose from the dead, he showed us that this kind of love is always worth it. It's stronger than death. Real love is unusual.

Meditación Evangélico

19 de febrero de 2023 7º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

"Confió, Señor, en tu misericordia; alegra mi corazón con tu auxilio. Cantaré al Señor por el bien que me ha hecho" (Salmo 12,6). Estamos llamados a ir más allá de nosotros mismos en todas las cosas que realizamos en la vida cotidiana. En otras palabras, el amor no puede tener condiciones, se ama al

máximo o no se ama. Los ejemplos que tenemos de amor en las telenovelas, o los *reality shows*, son de fantasía y de acomodo al egoísmo.

Lo que Jesús propone es darlo todo hasta el tope, hasta el fondo del corazón. Como los abuelitos que cuidan de sus nietos con toda el alma; o como los cuidadores de enfermos que lo dan todo para el alivio y descanso en la enfermedad; o como los padres de familia que trabajan sin descanso para llevar el pan a la mesa.

Jesús nos llama en el Evangelio a la coherencia cristiana, a comenzar un camino espiritual que nos renueve desde el fondo del corazón. No más ojo por ojo ni diente por diente. Eso de amar a los enemigos es diferente: "Si alguien te hace un pleito por la camisa, entrégale también el manto. Si alquien te obliga a llevarle la carga, llévasela el doble más lejos. Da al que te pida, y al que espera de ti algo prestado, no le vuelvas la espalda. (Mateo 5,40-42). Pero, ¿cómo Señor? eso es muy difícil de llevar. Cuando presto, cobro a toda hora. Si me piden ayudar con alguna responsabilidad en la familia, mejor me retiro dando miles de excusas, que estoy cansado u ocupado. Puede ser, pero desde el mensaje del Evangelio, el amor lo puede todo.


