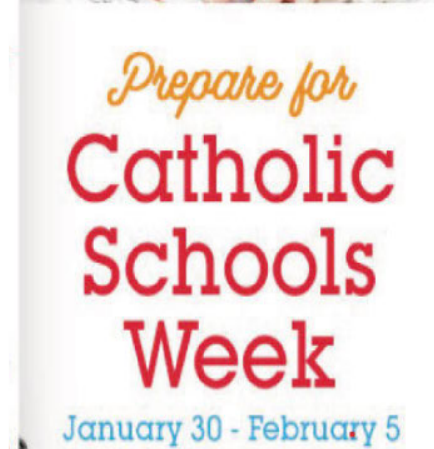

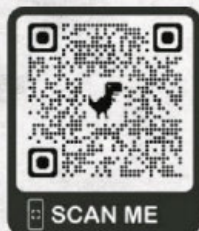

The Walk to Emmaus—Luke 24.13-35



Now on that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, and talking with each other about all these things that had happened. While they were talking and

discussing, Jesus himself came near and went with them, but their eyes were kept from recognising him. And he said to them, ‘What are you discussing with each other while you walk along?’ They stood still, looking sad. Then one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answered him, ‘Are you the only stranger in Jerusalem who does not know the things that have taken place there in these days?’ He asked them, ‘What things?’ They replied, ‘The things about Jesus of Nazareth, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, and how our chief priests and leaders handed him over to be condemned to death and crucified him. But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since these things took place. Moreover, some women of our group astounded us. They were at the tomb early this morning, and when they did not find his body there, they came back and told us that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who said that he was alive. Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but they did not see him.’ Then he said to them, ‘Oh, how foolish you are, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have declared! Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and then enter into his glory?’ Then beginning with Moses and all the prophets, he interpreted to them the things about himself in all the scriptures.

El Camino a Emaús—Lucas 24:13-35

Agora, naquele mesmo dia, dois deles estavam indo para uma aldeia chamada Emaús, a cerca de sete milhas de Jerusalém, e conversando entre si sobre todas essas coisas que haviam acontecido. Enquanto conversavam e discutiam, o próprio Jesus se aproximou e foi com eles, mas seus olhos foram impedidos de reconhecê-lo. E ele disse a eles: ‘O que vocês estão discutindo um com o outro enquanto caminham?’ Eles ficaram parados, parecendo tristes. Então um deles, que se chamava Cleofas, lhe respondeu: ‘Você é o único estrangeiro em Jerusalém que não sabe das coisas que aconteceram lá nestes dias?’ Ele lhes perguntou: ‘Que coisas?’ Eles responderam: ‘As coisas sobre Jesus de Nazaré, que foi um profeta poderoso em obras e palavras diante de Deus e de todo o povo, e como nossos principais sacerdotes e líderes o entregaram para ser condenado à morte e o crucificaram. Mas esperávamos que fosse ele quem redimiria Israel. Sim, e além de tudo isso, já é o terceiro dia desde que essas coisas aconteceram. Além disso, algumas mulheres do nosso grupo nos surpreenderam. Eles estavam no túmulo esta manhã, e quando eles não encontraram seu corpo lá, eles voltaram e nos disseram que eles realmente tiveram uma visão de anjos que disseram que ele estava vivo. Alguns dos que estavam conosco foram ao túmulo e o encontraram exatamente como as mulheres haviam dito; mas eles não o viram.’ Então ele lhes disse: ‘Oh, quão tolos vocês são e quão lentos de coração para acreditar em tudo o que os profetas declararam! Não era necessário que o Messias sofresse essas coisas e depois entrasse em sua glória?’ Então, começando por Moisés e todos os profetas, ele interpretou para eles as coisas a seu respeito em todas as Escrituras.

A Caminhada para Emaús — Lucas 24.13-35

Ahora bien, ese mismo día, dos de ellos iban a un pueblo llamado Emaús, como a siete millas de Jerusalén, y hablaban entre sí acerca de todas estas cosas que habían sucedido. Mientras hablaban y discutían, Jesús mismo se acercó y fue con ellos, pero sus ojos no lo reconocieron. Y él les dijo: ‘¿Qué discutís entre vosotros mientras camináis?’ Ellos se quedaron quietos, con cara de tristeza. Entonces uno de ellos, cuyo nombre era Cleofás, le respondió: ‘¿Eres tú el único forastero en Jerusalén que no sabe las cosas que han sucedido allí en estos días?’ Él les preguntó: ‘¿Qué cosas?’ Ellos respondieron: ‘Las cosas de Jesús de Nazaret, que fue un profeta poderoso en obras y palabras delante de Dios y de todo el pueblo, y cómo nuestros principales sacerdotes y líderes lo entregaron para ser condenado a muerte y lo crucificaron. Pero esperábamos que él fuera el que redimiría a Israel. Sí, y además de todo esto, ya es el tercer día desde que estas cosas sucedieron. Además, algunas mujeres de nuestro grupo nos sorprendieron. Estuvieron en la tumba temprano esta mañana, y como no encontraron su cuerpo allí, regresaron y nos dijeron que efectivamente habían visto una visión de ángeles que decían que estaba vivo. Algunos de los que estaban con nosotros fueron al sepulcro y lo encontraron tal como las mujeres habían dicho; pero ellos no le vieron. Entonces él les dijo: ¡Oh, qué insensatos sois, y qué tardos de corazón para creer todo lo que los profetas han dicho! ¿No era necesario que el Mesías padeciera estas cosas y luego entrara en su gloria?’ Entonces, comenzando desde Moisés y todos los profetas, les interpretó las cosas acerca de sí mismo en todas las Escrituras.

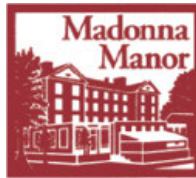

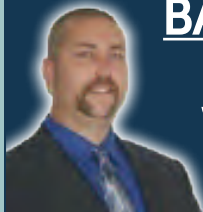

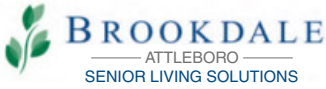
