the parish who have asked the Wellness Committee to present another session dealing with aging, dementia, and Alzheimer's, we are happy to announce the Committee has heard your request!


Monday, June 7, at 7 pm there will be an online presentation on those topics. The session, which will be on ZOOM, will be given by
