NATIONAL Eucharistic Revival

Last weekend, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. That weekend the Church in the United States began a National Eucharistic Revival.

This is a three-year initiative sponsored by the Bishops of the United States to inspire and prepare the people of God to be formed, healed, converted, united, and sent out to a hurting and hungry world through a renewed encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—the source and summit of our Catholic faith.

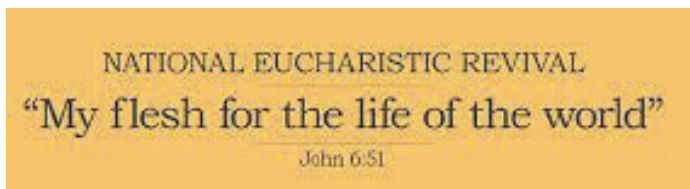
Grounded in prayer, the National Eucharistic Revival has four primary goals.

1. To provide a more profound encounter with Jesus Christ in the Sunday liturgy as a point of unity among all Catholics, and through this powerful encounter to find personal healing and the courage to take the gospel to a world in need of authentic love—the love of Christ found in the Eucharist.

2. To spark personal conversion through the joyful discovery of a relationship with Christ by encountering the love of God present in Jesus in the Eucharist.

3. To elevate the truth and practice of our Catholic faith through the rediscovery of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist, which is the source and summit of our Church and of who we are as the People of God.

4. To form, inspire and launch missionary disciples filled with the love of God and neighbor that comes from an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist, to the margins of the Church and the world.

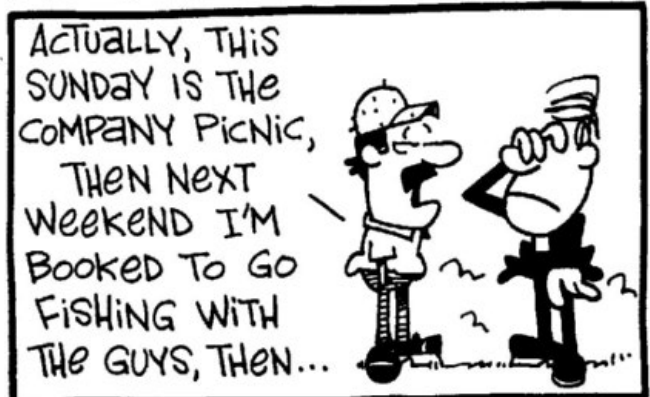
