

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mercy,

Greetings in the name of Our Lord Jesus Christ!

With today's celebration of the Solemnity of Christ the King, we come to the last Sunday in the liturgical calendar. Next weekend will be the First Sunday of Advent and the start of the liturgical year of 2024. That means that Christmas is around the corner!

I know that time flies by so quickly these days, so we had better hurry to prepare ourselves to meet the Lord. And what does that mean? It means that as time quickly passes us by, our time here on earth is getting shorter.

Besides our regular Mass schedule for Sunday, December 24, we will have our Christmas Eve Masses in the evening at 5 pm and 10 pm (our "midnight Mass"). Then the next day, Christmas Day, Masses will be at 8 am, 10 am and 12 noon. We will post this schedule again in future bulletins.

Last but not least, I would like to ask you to be generous to your parish. Kindly increase your weekly donations. We have projects to do in our building such as installing a chair lift to access the Maria Room (parish hall) and upgrading our church restrooms. These are the priorities for now. 
Also, please be sure to read the article about Henry Racelis, who was recently appointed a trustee of our parish. I am happy for his willingness to serve in this important role.

Masses may be scheduled on weekdays during regular office hours, 8 am to 3 pm, and on Saturdays and Sundays, between 9 am to 1 pm.

Please note that during the first month the Mass Book is open, we request that parishioners book no more than 5 Masses. In addition to Mass intentions, you may also make donations for the sanctuary lamp and for the bread and wine used at our Masses.

#### THE ROLE OF THE PARISH TRUSTEE The following information is from the Pastor's Administrative Manual published by the Archdiocese of Newark.

The two lay trustees serve on the civil governing body of the parish corporation. They assist with ordinary business and exercise their powers as necessary and proper for attaining the corporation's purposes...Lay trustees should be members in good standing of the parish, be active participants in the parish community, have relevant business experience or ability, and have the commitment needed for the position. The two lay trustees can be male or female. Lay trustees are appointed at the annual meeting of the parish corporation and serve a term of one year. There is no limit on the number of terms one individual may serve.

Return your gifts by Sunday, December 17. Place them under the trees or bring the gifts to the parish office.


