Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mercy,

Hallelujah!

Next Sunday, April 21, is Good Shepherd Sunday. It gets its name from the day's Gospel passage that speaks of a good shepherd caring for his sheep. I ask you to read that passage at home (John 10:11-18) so that you will be well prepared to hear it at Mass.

Let the Holy Spirit speak to your heart as you read the Gospel and as you hear it preached about at Mass next weekend. Think about the message the Holy Spirit is giving you in this day and age when there is a lot of noise and different voices around us. I strongly believe that each one of you, each one of us, has a task from the Lord that he wants us to do as we enjoy and live this life. Try to discover it.

Last weekend, those of us who attended our Seniors Café enjoyed "Music and Memory" with Liam Barredo, our Music Director. It may have brought back memories of those days when we were younger and had our favorite song or songs. It was nice to be transported to those days and remember happy or not so happy memories.

As I was sitting in the back of the Maria Room, listening to Liam and recalling my favorite songs, I felt some pain and sadness because I did not enjoy my childhood days due to my parents' strictness. But coming to my senses later in life, I learned to be grateful for that strictness because it helped shape the person I am and where I am today. It helped me to learn many things and to develop a lot of virtues. So, in the name of those who attended and our whole community, thank you Liam! Let us do it again.

For two consecutive weekends, beginning next weekend, there will be four groups of children who will receive their First Eucharist. I ask you to include them in your prayers. Pray that they will truly appreciate the gift of the Eucharist that Jesus instituted at his Last Supper with his disciples. May they grow in their love of God. Pray also for our Confirmation class children. They are in their final months of preparation.
