

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mercy,

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

I would like to invite you to reflect with me on this weekend's scripture readings. They encourage us to take a serious look at how we are living the Christian vocation that is ours through baptism. We are to be bearers of God's message to other people. We are to spread the Good News of salvation.

In the first reading (Ezekiel 2:2-5), we have the prophet Ezekiel complaining to God about his mission to go and speak to a rebellious, hard-hearted, and obstinate nation. Ezekiel did not feel as if he would accomplish anything, but he knew that God sent him because, at the very least, the people would recognize that there was a real prophet among them.

In the second reading (2 Corinthians 12:7-10), St Paul came to understand that God did not want a perfect person to go and speak for him. God wanted Saint Paul with all his imperfections. With his evident failings, the people would realize that what Saint Paul was saying and writing did not come from himself, but rather, from God.

Once Saint Paul came to accept that truth, he was content to continue doing God's work despite his weaknesses and to bear up under the insults, hardships, and persecutions that came with doing God's work.

If we think about ourselves, some of us may see ourselves like St. Paul. We feel that God could not possibly want us to speak out on his behalf. Maybe we feel unworthy, or we are afraid that people will accuse us of being some kind of hypocrite because we're not perfect. Well, the simple truth is, none of us is perfect. We all have our own "thorn" in the flesh to cause us to doubt and second-guess God's choice.

To be truly faithful to God is not just about believing in the gospel when everything is going well, it is also a matter of persevering in the faith when we are facing trials and tribulations.

Brothers and sisters, we know that God's Church is suffering in various parts of the world and yes, even here. Sadly, there are members of the Church who come not to worship God and receive spiritual nourishment but who look for ways to pull down those in leadership instead of helping and building them up. But that is only to be expected when you are trying to do God's will.

It is often the messengers or prophets among us who are the ones being targeted. So, when we hear about problems, challenges, or scandals we should not give up on our faith. This is just God's way of reminding us that the truth of our faith is not dependent on its messengers. The message of Jesus does not depend on how good and perfect our leaders are. It is about God himself, and how God wants to bring us closer to him in faith.

I hope and pray that we wake up to God's call to be holy because life is short. We need to make the most of every day and every minute of our lives.

Father Orlando Gonzalez will describe the Church's work on the islands and request our support for the Church's mission work among the people of the Turks and Caicos Islands.


