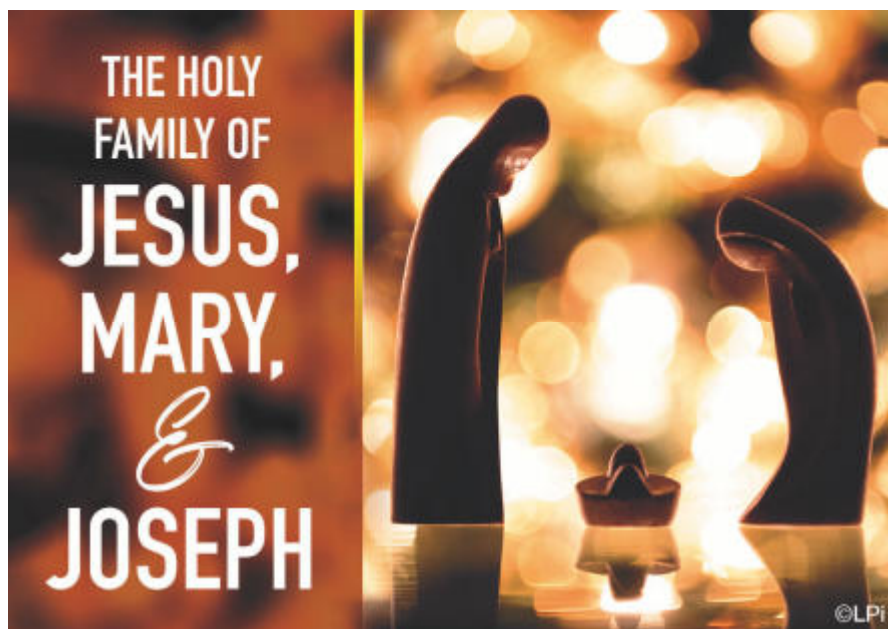

## THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY, AND JOSEPH

A healthy family breeds a healthy church and a healthy society. It is the family that provides us with a home. The “home” is where we live and love together through many changing years, where we share each other’s joy and success and wipe each other’s tears. The family is a precious gift of God. We all need the family.

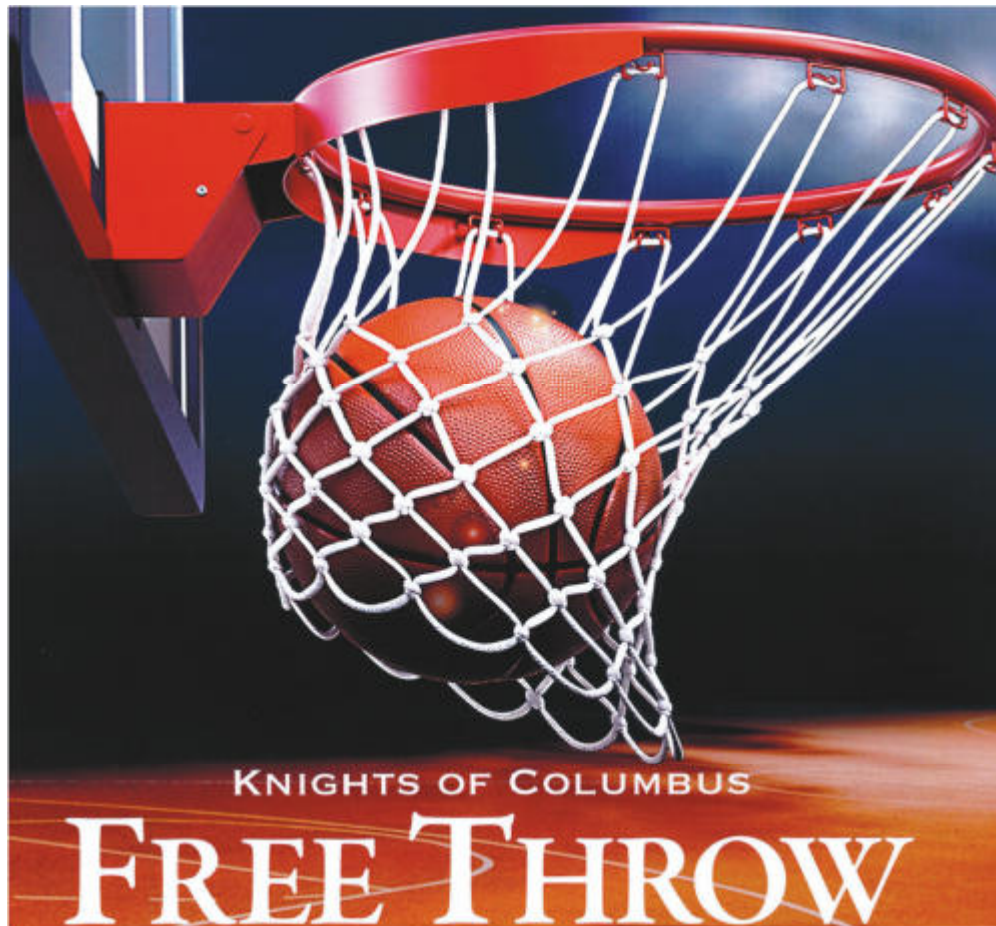
The second Vatican council calls the family a *domestic church*. A family is a Christian family if Christ is at its center. Where Christ reigns, love abounds. “The family that prays together stays together.” In *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*, Pope Saint John Paul II says, “we need to return to the practice of family prayer and prayer for families, continuing to use the **Rosary**.” When a family ceases to be a praying family, love begins to wane; resentment and anger grow more profound by the day.

Husband, wife, and children form the world’s most outstanding team. Whether this team wins or loses depends mainly on the love that binds them. Where genuine love is, joy is shared, and sorrow eased. Love is not just a feeling of compassion but a constant attitude of service towards others and a readiness to forgive and suffer. If every member of the family feels at the service of the other members, then all difficulties can easily be overcome.

As we celebrate the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, we also celebrate the gift of our own families today. When the Holy Family is put before us as a model to imitate, we think that is impossible. We say they are so far beyond us in holiness that imitating them is not possible. We may not be the perfect family, but we are a holy family if we are in God’s grace. It’s God’s grace that makes us holy, and if members of a family stay in God’s grace, they will be a holy family. No family can ever hope to be perfect as the Holy Family of Nazareth was, but every family must strive to imitate it.

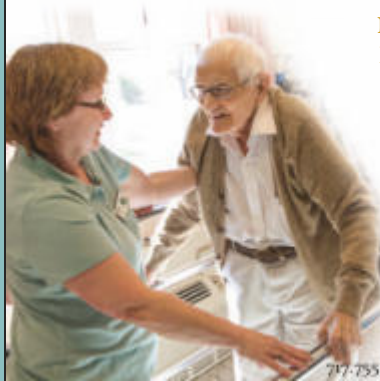

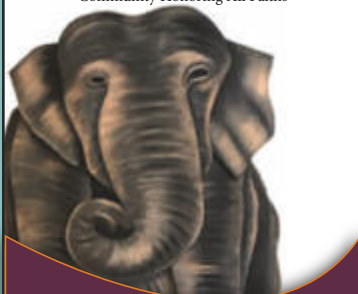
