

#### From the Pastor's Desk

#### The Epiphany of the Lord

The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek, epiphainen, a verb that means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." Thus, the feast of the Epiphany celebrates the many ways that Christ has made himself known to the world. There are three main events that manifested the mission and divinity of Christ: the visit of the Magi (Matthew 2:1-12), the baptism of Jesus (Mark 1:9-11), and the miracle at Cana (John 2:1-11). The feast of Epiphany emphasizes the visit of the Magi. We celebrate Christ's baptism the first Sunday that follows.

The magi brought three gifts, namely, gold, frank-incense and myrrh. These gifts were certainly not typical gifts for a baby. The gold and frankincense reveal the identity of the Messiah. They fulfill the prophecy of Isaiah in today's first reading: "Dromedaries from Midian and Ephah, all from Sheba shall come bearing gold and frankincense and proclaiming the praises of the Lord." The gold and frankincense show that Jesus is King and God. Incense is used to worship this Messiah as God.

Myrrh was used to anoint bodies for burial. We are taught that "though immortal and eternal as God, this Messiah will embrace death in order to save us. Unlike any other king, this Messiah's throne will be a cross and his crown will be made of thorns. He will be dressed in royal purple and proclaimed king only by his torturers, who in mockery hung above his head the words: 'Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews (INRI). Torturers whom he forgave, for whom also he died, for whom also he came to save. So gold for a king, incense for God and myrrh because he will die to save us."

Happy feast of the Epiphany.



### 20 + C + M + B + 22 May Christ Bless This Home

On the feast of the Epiphany, which means "manifestation", it is traditional to ask God's blessing on our homes. The current year and the initials C, M, B are marked above the main doorway. There are two explanations for the three initials: Christus Mansionem Benedicat, which means, "May Christ bless this home". It is also the initials of the legendary names of the Magi (Casper, Melchior, and Balthazar). While placing this blessing above the door way of your home, say:

"May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living amount us; and may we seek and serve Christ in everyone we meet. Amen"




