

The Catholic Community of St. Mark has arranged a special Liturgy focusing on the charism of Healing on Sun, August 29 at 5 PM. The music, homily, and prayer of the faithful are chosen to increase our faith that Jesus is indeed the healer of our infirmities, both our physical pain and our "heartaches."

Catholics believe that healing occurs during all Masses. God wants to heal us and will heal through the powerful gifts given to us by the Holy Spirit. This is one of God's gifts to His Church. During a healing Mass and service, we must remain open to the Holy Spirit and invite Him into our hearts in order for healing to take place.

During the Mass, we pray for:

The sick to be made whole and their caretakers be strengthened by faith. People in broken relationships, that they may be given the strength only God's love can bring. All who have endured illness or brokenness and who wait in the hope of God's healing care.

The Liturgical celebration concludes with Benediction and a hymn in gratitude to the Blessed Mother. Priests will be available to hear confessions throughout the evening.

I invite you to bring your friends, family, and loved ones and join us! All are welcome, especially those who are sick or suffering in any way, mind, body, or spirit. All that's required on our part is to have expectant faith. The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be administered during Mass.

Let's remember that God is doing all the healing. The celebrant and other priests are only instruments the Lord is using to provide a prayerful environment for Him to work in.


