A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear St. Mark Parish Family,

Christ is risen! Indeed He is risen!

This hope is echoed in the words we so often proclaim at Mass, "Christ has died, Christ is risen, and Christ will come again! In the years left to them the apostles preached this belief and this hope. They preached a message of hope to people who had never seen Jesus. They told all who would listen to them: "Your sins are forgiven by Jesus who is alive and with you. Your hearts are comforted by the love of Jesus who is alive and with you. Your minds are enlightened by Jesus who is alive and with you. Your struggles with yourself are no longer yours alone but you have Jesus alive and with you."
