A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY.....To mothers, both biological and adopted, connected by blood and by experience. To those who have given life both in birth and in formation, to those who have lost life before birth and before old age...To those who have done what only mothers can do, to those who have been "the perfect mother" and to those who live with regrets, to those who are close to their children, and to those who feel like they are a million miles away...We bless you today, on this day, Mother's Day.

To those who feel the pain of children long desired but never received, we grieve with you the too often secret pain you have borne. I am very grateful for the hard work and dedication of all the women in this parish. No matter where I have ever been as a seminarian or as a priest, I have always seen the promise of Jesus fulfilled: "And everyone who has left houses, brothers, sisters, father, mother, children or land for the sake of my name will be repaid a hundred times over, and also inherit eternal life" (Matthew 19: 29).

My prayer is that the Holy Spirit will fill all women with the gift of love and that they may fully understand their true dignity as daughters of the awesome God of love. "The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace."
