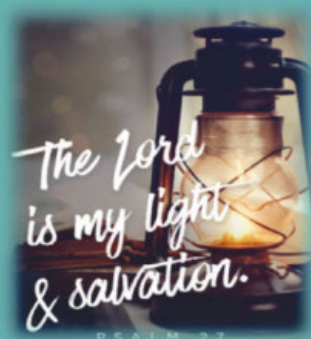

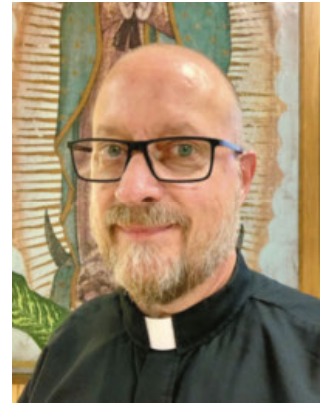

Pastor's Corner



Dear Parishioners,

Saint Paul exhorts the Corinthians: "that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and in the same purpose." He urges them to be one in Jesus Christ.

What does it mean for us Catholics to be one? What is unity? As Catholics we profess that we believe in One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church. Where does our unity as believers come from?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that, "The Holy Spirit brings about the wonderful communion of the faithful." The Church has a diversity of peoples, cultures, gifts, and offices and particular Churches with their own traditions. This rich diversity does not oppose Church unity. Our unity is a spiritual unity.

The Church has three important visible bonds of communion:

1. The profession of one faith
2. The common celebration of worship (especially through the sacraments)
3. Apostolic succession through Holy Orders

Jesus left the Church His teachings. When we all profess together the one Faith that Jesus gave to His Church, we are united in mind.

When we celebrate together, through the sacraments, the Faith of the Church, we become one in our worship.

When we practice our faith and strive to live the moral teachings of the Church in union with the successors of the Apostles and promote the mission of the Church, we become one in purpose.

Where do divisions among the faithful come from? Fissures in the unity of the Church come from ruptures in the above three bonds of communion.

Each and every one of us should be promoters of unity and harmony in the Church.

GODPARENT

Those requesting a Sponsor Certificate for Baptism or Confirmation must meet the following requirements before they can obtain a Sponsor Certificate:

1. Be an active parishioner.
2. Attend Mass every Sunday at St. Patrick or Saint Augustine and assist with the material needs of the Church, each according to his/her abilities.
3. Must be over 16 years of age.
4. Must have received all Sacraments of initiation (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation).
5. If married, be married according to the laws of the Catholic Church.
6. If unmarried, cannot be cohabitating with a significant other.

Everyone must call the office to make an appointment to meet with a priest to determine suitability. (See Catechism of the Catholic Church 2042; Code of Canon Law 874).

PADRINOS

Si desea ser padrino/madrina de Bautizo o Confirmación debe cumplir con los siguientes requisitos antes de obtener el certificado necesario:

1. Estar activo en la parroquia
2. Ir a Misa todos los domingos en San Patricio o San Agustín y contribuir a las necesidades materiales de la Iglesia según su capacidad.
3. Debe ser mayor de 16 años
4. Tener los Sacramentos de iniciación (Bautizo, Comunión, Confirmación).
5. Si son casados debe ser bajo las leyes de la Iglesia Católica.
6. Si no son casados, no deben estar cohabitando con su pareja.

Todos deben llamar a la oficina para hacer una cita para reunirse con un sacerdote para determinar la idoneidad. (Ver Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica 2042; Código de Derecho Canónico 874).


